### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### MAKING THE MOST OF HOLY WEEK



Holy Week is the most important time of the year for Catholics. This year Holy Week runs from Sunday, April 2 until Sunday, April 9. During this week, we recall together what the Son of God did to save us from our sins and from having to spend eternity suffering because of our sins. Truly Jesus is our hero and we love Him because of the great sacrifice He made to save us.

We begin Holy Week with **Palm Sunday of the Passion**. The reading of the Passion by one of the synoptics helps us to appreciate the loving sacrifice of Jesus. On Monday of Holy Week, we will have the **Chrism Mass** at the Cathedral when the Bishop will bless the three types of holy oils that are used in the sacraments. On Tuesday and Wednesday of Holy Week, we will have evening confession times.

On **Holy Thursday**, we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:30 pm when we will recall the gifts Jesus created for us of the Sacrament of his Body and Blood and of the Sacramental Priesthood.

On **Good Friday**, we recall the suffering of Jesus on the day that He died. At 3 pm, we will read the Passion, venerate the wood of the cross, and receive Jesus in Holy Communion (we will repeat this Mass in Spanish at 6 pm on Good Friday). On Friday evening, at 7:30 pm, we recall the **Seven Last Words of Jesus** in church.

Jesus promised that He would rise from the dead in three days. On **Holy Saturday**, after sunset, we begin to celebrate Christ's new life on Easter. Our first Mass will be on Saturday at 8 pm. On **Easter Sunday**, we will have four Masses at 7:30, 9 and 11 am and at 12:30 pm in Spanish.

I hope you will all make an extra effort to join us for our parish celebration of the greatest gift that God has ever given us of new life in Christ through the saving Passion and Resurrection of Jesus!

### 24-HOUR EUCHARISTIC ADORATION Available at St. Lawrence Church every Thursday from 5 pm until Friday at 5 pm.

When going to Eucharistic Adoration, enter the chapel or church where Eucharistic Adoration has been made available in silence and reverence. Genuflect on both knees before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and make the Sign of the Cross. Then kneel or sit in prayer, recite favorite prayers, the rosary, or a chaplet. Sit and do some spiritual reading, write in a prayer journal, meditate and give thanks. It's a time to contemplate acts of faith, hope and charity; a time to simply be in the presence of Jesus; a time to listen to the Holy Spirit; a time to examine one's conscience in preparation for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Many people sign up for a specific hour of Adoration each week — it is their personal time with Jesus. We have several openings in our adoration schedule. We especially need volunteers during our night hours from Thursday night until Friday morning when the sacrifice to attend is greater.

St. Teresa of Calcutta said: "... Eucharistic Adoration with exposition needs a great push. People ask me: What will convert America and save the world? My answer is prayer. What we need is for every parish to come before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament in holy hours of prayer."

St. John Paul II wrote: "Our communal worship at Mass must go together with our personal worship of Jesus in Eucharistic adoration so that our love may be complete."



V Domingo del Tiempo de Cuaresma Lecturas domingo 26 de marzo del 2023

Primera Lectura: Ez 37, 12-14

Salmo 129, 1-2, 3-4ab, 4c-6, 7-8

Segunda Lectura: Rm 8, 8-11

Evangelio Jn 11, 1-45

"Yo soy la resurrección y la vida, dice el Señor; el que cree en mí no morirá para siempre." Jn 11, 25. 26

El Evangelio de este quinto domingo de Cuaresma nos narra la resurrección de Lázaro. Es la cumbre de los «signos» prodigiosos realizados por Jesús: es un gesto demasiado grande, demasiado claramente divino para ser tolerado por los sumos sacerdotes, quienes, al conocer el hecho, tomaron la decisión de matar a Jesús (cf. Jn 11, 53). Lázaro estaba muerto desde hacía cuatro días, cuando llegó Jesús; y a las hermanas Marta y María les dijo palabras que se grabaron para siempre en la memoria de la comunidad cristiana. Dice así Jesús: «Yo soy la resurrección y la vida: el que cree en mí, aunque haya muerto, vivirá; y el que está vivo y cree en mí, no morirá para siempre» (Jn 11, 25-26). Basados en esta Palabra del Señor creemos que la vida de quien cree en Jesús y sigue sus mandamientos, después de la muerte será transformada en una vida nueva, plena e inmortal. Como Jesús que resucitó con el propio cuerpo, pero no volvió a una vida terrena, así nosotros resucitaremos con nuestros cuerpos que serán transfigurados en

Ante la tumba sellada del amigo Lázaro, Jesús «gritó con voz potente: "Lázaro, sal afuera". El muerto salió, los pies y las manos atados con vendas, y la cara envuelta en un sudario» (vv. 43-44). Este grito perentorio se dirige a cada hombre, porque todos estamos marcados por la muerte, todos nosotros; es la voz de Aquel que es el dueño de la vida y quiere que todos «la tengan en abundancia» (Jn 10, 10). Cristo no se resigna a los sepulcros que nos hemos construido con nuestras opciones de mal y de muerte, con nuestros errores, con nuestros pecados. Él no se resigna a esto. Él nos invita, casi nos ordena salir de la tumba en la que nuestros pecados nos han sepultado. Nos llama insistentemente a salir de la oscuridad de la prisión en la que estamos encerrados, contentándonos con una vida falsa, egoísta, mediocre. «Sal afuera», nos dice, «Sal afuera». Es una hermosa invitación a la libertad auténtica, a dejarnos aferrar por estas palabras de Jesús que hoy repite a cada uno de nosotros. Una invitación a dejarnos liberar de las «vendas», de las vendas del orgullo. Porque el orgullo nos hace esclavos, esclavos de nosotros mismos, esclavos de tantos ídolos, de tantas cosas. Nuestra resurrección comienza desde aquí: cuando decidimos obedecer a este mandamiento de Jesús saliendo a la luz, a la vida; cuando caen de nuestro rostro las máscaras —muchas veces estamos enmascarados por el pecado, las máscaras tienen que caer— y volvemos a encontrar el valor de nuestro rostro original, creado a imagen y semejanza de Dios. El gesto de Jesús que resucita a Lázaro muestra hasta dónde puede llegar la fuerza de la gracia de Dios, y, por lo tanto, hasta dónde puede llegar nuestra conversión, nuestro cambio. Pero escuchad bien: no existe límite alguno para la misericordia divina ofrecida a todos. No existe límite alguno para la misericordia divina ofrecida a todos, recordad bien esta frase.
