FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

THE SAINT LAWRENCE THE MARTYR PASTORAL ADVISORY BOARD



This coming Tuesday, our parish Pastoral Advisory Board, aka PAB, will meet. The PAB is a consultative group, not a decision-making body. The PAB has several purposes. One is to help the pastor to make good decisions. The pastor brings to the attention of the board members what is happening in parish life so that he can hear their thoughts and seek their wisdom. For example, we are currently trying to re-open the Barn Ministry in the parish and need to come to a resolution about the furniture for Haiti that is stored there. I will ask the Board

members for their thoughts on how to transport the furniture to our sister parish in Dufailly, Haiti, or at least to remove it from the Barn. We will also discuss the US Bishops request that the US Church engage in a Eucharistic Revival. Other subjects will be discussed, too, on Tuesday.

The PAB is also a place where the pastor can inform the members about various initiatives in parish life and discuss them with the members. A number of initiatives have begun since the Board last met. The makeup of the Board is meant to represent the composition of our community. We try to have representatives from the long time parishioners, from the immigrant population, from the young families, from the young adults, and from different age groups. The PAB is also a forum where the members' concerns can be discussed. The Board tries to meet four times per year and membership is by appointment of the pastor.


