FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

JULY, THE MONTH OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS



I remember many years ago attending to a family who had experienced a horrific tragedy. I had been called to anoint the body of a woman who had been knifed by a crazed man. The woman had been attacked while she was in bed. When I arrived, I saw that her bed and pillow were soaked with her blood. The police were at the crime scene when I arrived and one police officer was tossing the pillow in the trash with a careless remark about the pillow. He said, "What is this s---?" After he

tossed away the blood-soaked pillow, the daughter of the deceased woman chastised him for his choice of words about her mother's pillow. I remember thinking that an element in the daughter's sensitivity was that the pillow was soaked with her dear mother's blood. Clearly the blood of the mother and her pillow were sacred to the daughter.

In the movie, the "Passion of the Christ" by Mel Gibson, there is a moving scene in which the wife of Pontius Pilate brings linens to our Blessed Mother so that Mary could wipe up the precious blood of her dear son from the pavement upon which he had been scourged. The blood of a loved one is a sacred relic. And so, it surely is with the Precious Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ! You and I are washed clean with the blood of the Lamb.



A PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS

"Whoever receives you receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one who sent me...And whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones to drink because the little one is a disciple - amen, I say to you, he will surely not lose his reward."

How frequently in the Church we find the word 'receive' to describe important moments. We receive communion and confirmation, we receive absolution and anointing of the sick. It almost seems like a passive moment. Yet Jesus speaks of an action which describes our life, to give only a cup of cold water.

As we give and as we accept, we are drawn closer to the Lord. The reward is God's grace to live with Him. Grace is the life of God, not merited, offered to us as a gift, and accepted. We move from receiving to acting as a true disciple.

In this time when we buy bottled water while others are deprived of good clean water, may we use the message of Jesus to discover how we can give Him to others as a cup of water, as a cup of kindness, as a cup of care and concern. There is definitely a reward.


