FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

SAINT IGNATIUS OF LOYOLA AND PRAYING WITH THE BIBLE



The Jesuits are known by many people for their colleges, like Georgetown, Loyola, Boston College, the University of San Francisco, Creighton, Saint Louis University and many others. The founder of the Jesuits was St. Ignatius of Loyola.

St. Ignatius of Loyola made great contributions to the life of the Catholic Church. One such contribution is Ignatian Discernment. Another is a method for praying with the Bible. I would like to say a little about his prayer with the Bible.

Jesus and the Eucharist should be at the center of our lives. Part of placing Jesus at the center is to converse with Him every day. Reading the Bible in the context of praying helps us to converse with Jesus. St. Ignatius suggested that when we read the Gospels, we place ourselves in the scene described in the Gospel story. Within the scene, looking at Jesus and listening to Jesus, we aim to learn as much as we can from Him. Once we come to love Jesus, we want to follow Him and learn as much as we can from Him. Those who choose to follow Jesus are called His disciples.

The Church offers us an ancient and highly effective way to converse with Jesus using the Bible. This way or method is called Lectio Divina. Lectio is generally described as having four parts. The first part is to read the Bible story. It is generally suggested that we read the passage two times. The second part is to meditate on the passage. Meditating here means thinking about what Jesus is saying to us personally through the passage. In this second part, we can apply the method of St. Ignatius to our advantage. The third part is to converse with Jesus about what we have heard Him say. And the fourth part is to try to retain and apply what we have learned. Conversing with Jesus allows us to become more like him, to truly be in His image and likeness.

Conversing with Jesus while using a Bible passage helps us to become more like Jesus and to grow closer to Him. We priests and deacons and some others, too, would be happy to help you to learn to pray with the Bible.


