FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO CARRY ABOUT THE DYING OF JESUS?



In his second letter to the Corinthians, in the fourth chapter, chapter 10, St. Paul writes, "I continually carry about in my body the dying of Jesus." This line has a rich meaning. St. Paul refers to the dying of Jesus and we know that Jesus died to save us. It cost Jesus a great deal to save us from our sins and their consequences. In His passion, Jesus suffered greatly. As we try to bring others to faith in Jesus, we know that it can require much effort and suffering at times, too. This is one meaning of 1 Corinthians 4:10.

Another meaning of carrying about in our bodies the dying of Jesus is the "purgative stage" of the ascent to full union with God. The three persons of God live in full union with each other. In God's plan, He is inviting us all to seek full union with Him, too. Sin stands in the way of union with God. The saints report that the first stage of seeking full union with God is the purgative stage. In this stage, we seek to overcome our sins. We seek to put them to death. Destroying our sins is a way to understand "carrying about in our bodies the dying of Jesus." This purgative stage requires an ongoing effort and attention. We must remain faithful to our daily prayer time. We need the strength and grace that God gives us during prayer time to succeed in our journey to full union with God.
