THE POWER OF THE CROSS TO TOUCH THE HEART



This past Sunday, a group of parishioners and I listened to a teaching by Eileen George about meditating on the cross of Jesus. She guided us in her recorded teaching to consider the crown of thorns on His head, the wounds in His hands, the wounds in His feet, and the large wound in His side. She guided us to recall the great pain He endured for us. She led us to pray with her to Him to ask for His forgiveness. After all, He would not have suffered so much if we had never sinned. Please recall that He died to save us from our sins.

As we meditate on the passion and the death of Jesus, we are touched by the great love that He demonstrated on Calvary. Our recognition of that great love moves us to true sorrow for our sins and moves us to repentance. Please recall that our repentance is necessary for His saving grace to be effective for us. Meditation on the suffering and death of Jesus is great source of Jesus' saving grace. Please make time to meditate on His passion and death. Please take time to look at the crucifix!

The crucifix is a wonderful sacramental. Please have the cross on display in your homes. There should be one in every bedroom. It would be great to display the cross in the living areas, too.




