THE SEVEN SORROWS OF MARY AND THE HOLY CROSS

You may know that the Church dedicates each month to a certain element of our faith. May is the month of Mary, June is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, July is the month of the Precious Blood of Jesus, etc. The month of September is dedicated to the Seven Sorrows of Mary and to the Holy Cross of Jesus. The cross of Jesus and the sorrows of Mary are mysteries of sorrow, but they also fill us with hope



and awe. The cross of Jesus is called in Catholic tradition the Tree of Life. In the Book of Genesis, there was a Tree of Life also. In the heart of the Kingdom of God, there is another Tree of Life and it is the cross of Jesus. The cross of Jesus makes a powerful statement to us. The cross speaks of God's love and mercy. On the cross, Jesus suffered for you and for me to save us from the punishment that we owe for our sins. The mercy of God is available to us in the Sacraments where we can meet with Jesus and receive forgiveness and grace from God. The cross is the source of our new life with Christ.

Because of her great love for her son, the Blessed Mother suffered greatly as she witnessed His suffering throughout His life, but especially in His Passion and death. The Blessed Mother, like her Son, offered her sufferings to save you and me from our sins. We are most grateful to Mary for her work of mercy and salvation!


