The Jewish people were once taken in exile by the Babylonian Empire. While there in captivity, the Persians came and conquered the Babylonians and as a part of this conquest freed the Jewish captives and sent them to back to their land. In addition, Cyrus II gave orders for the rebuilding of the Jewish temple, for the return of the sacred temple objects that had been taken by the Babylonians, and that his kingdom would pay for the rebuilding of the Jerusalem Temple. This turn of events must have come as a great surprise to the Jewish people. I have no doubt that the Jewish people would have seen God's hand in their rescue from captivity in Babylon and would have been surprised and elated.

It is important when we have fears about the future of our church and the future of our families that we recall God's great rescues of the Jews form Egypt and from Babylon. Who could have possibly foreseen the great action of God in both of these predicaments? God did not abandon His chosen people and He will not abandon us!

MONDAY - MAY 13 CHESTER & KENNEDY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT
Depart by motorcoach from SAINT LAWRENCE THE MARTYR PARISH on route to KENNEDY
INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. You will be provided with assistance as you check in for AMERICAN
AIRLINES #0236 which is expected to depart at 5:00PM. Dinner will be served.

TUESDAY - MAY 14 ROME, PIETRACINA & SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO, ITALY Your flight will arrive into ROME at 7:15am. Depart by motorcoach en route to SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO via PIETRACINA to view the home of SAINT PIO. Check into THE PARCO DELLE ROSE HOTEL where dinner will be served. Afterward you might enjoy exploring the village on your own.

WEDNESDAY - MAY 15 SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO & MONTE SANT ANGELO Many miracles and "healings" have been attributed to SAINT PIO. During the morning you will experience sites of importance in his ministry beginning at THE SHRINE. During the afternoon you will be driven to visit THE SANCTUARY OF SAN MICHELE ARCANGELO (the site of SAINT MICHAEL'S apparitions in 490, 492 and 1656). Return to your hotel afterward where dinner will be served.

THURSDAY - MAY 16 SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO, LORETO & ASSISI
Depart from SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO after breakfast en route to ASSISI. Stop in LORETO to
experience THE BASILICA DE LA SANTA CASA (a MARIAN SHRINE which enshrines the HOUSE
which is believed by some to be THE HOME OF OUR BLESSED MOTHER). There will be time to have
lunch in the village before departing to ASSISI where you will check into THE FONTEBELLA PALACE
HOTEL where dinner will be served. Time to enjoy the village on your own during your stay in ASSISI.

FRIDAY - MAY 17 ASSISI

Enjoy a full day in and around ASSISI. A morning walking tour along colorful cobblestone streets will include a visit to THE BASILICA OF SAINT CLAIRE and will conclude at THE BASILICA OF SAINT FRANCIS. During the afternoon you will be taken to experience THE MONASTERY OF SAN DAMIANO; it is the site where SAINT FRANCIS heard the voice of OUR LORD saying, "FRANCIS, go and repair my church". Return afterward to your hotel where dinner will be served.

SATURDAY - MAY 18 ASSISI, BOLSENA & ROME
Begin today at THE BASILICA OF SAINT MARY OF THE ANGELS which contains THE
PORZIUNCOLA (the small chapel in which SAINT FRANCIS began THE FRANCISCAN ORDER).
Afterward depart through UMBRIA via BOLSENA (where a EUCHARISTIC MIRACLE occurred in 1263)
before arriving into ROME. Check into THE MICHELANGELO HOTEL where dinner will be served.

SUNDAY - MAY 19 VATICAN CITY & ROME

The morning will be spent in VATICAN CITY including a tour of THE BASILICA OF SAINT PETER and experiencing THE ANGELUS with OUR HOLY FATHER IN ST. PETER'S SQUARE. During the afternoon will include a visit to THE CATACOMBS along the ancient APPIAN WAY and THE BASILICA OF SAINT PAUL INSIDE THE WALLS. The day will conclude at your hotel; dine where you choose.

MONDAY - MAY 20 ROME

Begin today with visits to THE BASILICA OF SAINT JOHN IN LATERAN and "THE HOLY STAIRS". Afterward experience THE BASILICA OF SAINT AUGUSTINE (which contains the relics of SAINT MONICA), THE PANTHEON and the PIAZZA NOVANA. Then you will be driven to your hotel or you might choose to stay and enjoy "the historic" area of the city on your own. Dine where you choose.

TUESDAY - MAY 21 VATICAN CITY & ROME

Today includes a tour of the SISTINE CHAPEL as well as the opportunity for a tour of THE SCAVI EXCAVATIONS (the lowest levels underneath SAINT PETER'S BASILICA).
