### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

#### SOME OF THE HIGHLIGHTS OF OUR PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO ITALY

As you may know, I am leading a pilgrimage to a number of the shrines of Italy in May of 2024. I am very pleased with the itinerary and I would like to point out some of the highlights to you. We will leave New Jersey on May 13<sup>th</sup>. Our visit will begin in southern Italy where St. Padre Pio lived. We will visit his hometown and then go to his monastery and hospital in San Giovanni Rotondo. Near San Giovanni, there is a mountain where St. Michael the Archangel appeared a number of times. Several popes and St. Francis visited that mountain. The next leg of our pilgrimage will be to travel from the south of Italy to Assisi. En route to Assisi, we will visit Loretto, Italy where the upper portion of Mary's Nazareth home is now located and venerated. We will spend a part of three days in Assisi. There we will visit the Basilicas of Francis and Clare and the tomb of the popular young saint, Carlo Acutis. It will be our privilege to enjoy the peace of this much loved city.

From Assisi, we will finish our pilgrimage with a few days in Rome. En route to Rome, we will visit the Church of St. Cristina, the site of the Eucharistic miracle that gave rise to the great feast of Corpus Christi. In Rome, we will visit the major basilicas, including St. Peter's, St. Paul's, Santa Maria Maggiore, St. John in Laterano, St. Lawrence the Martyr, the Holy Steps from the palace of Pontius Pilate, the tomb of St. Monica (the great patron of mothers), the Sistine Chapel, and receive the Angelus Blessing of the Holy Father. The sites that we will visit have a great deal of charm and appeal. In addition, the Italian countryside is quite lovely and Italy's cuisine is appreciated worldwide.

Pilgrimages bring us many blessings. The Masses, the teachings, the confessions, the inspiring places and saints, offer us many graces. I hope that many of our people will be blessed by these graces!


#### **BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE**


