#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

#### THE FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF MARY



We believe that we can know with certainty that our mother, Mary of Nazareth, was immaculately conceived. This means that Mary was preserved by the grace of the death and the resurrection of Jesus from the effects of the sin of Adam and Eve. What are those effects? They are suffering, death and a universal tendency toward sin. Her immaculate conception is a grace that was sent to humanity through Jesus as a part of God's Divine Mercy initiative. However, just as Adam and Eve were created without a tendency toward sin, so Mary was created without that tendency toward sin that would come to Adam and Eve and all their descendants as a result of the sin of our first parents. Of course, Mary was capable of sin just as we are because God created us all with a free will. With our free will, we can choose sin and we can choose virtue. Our Blessed Mother never chose sin. She is our model. Mary would also experience temptations just as Jesus and we are tempted by Satan and the demons. Mary would resist all temptations. We are happy for her and we are proud of her. She is our protector and mother.







