FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

MARY AND THE MIRACULOUS



On December 12th, we celebrated the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe at St. Lawrence Church. As I meditated on the story of Mary's visit to Mexico, I was struck by the regular use of miracles by God during Mary's visits at different times and places. In Mary's visit to the Aztec and Spanish people at Guadalupe, Mexico, God worked a great miracle in the appearance of the Castilian roses in December and in the imprinting of Mary's apparition on the tilma of Juan Diego in the home of the Bishop of Mexico in 1531. In addition, Mary would heal the uncle of Juan Diego.

As a part of Mary's visits to St. Bernadette Soubirous in Lourdes in France in 1858, God and Mary would do the miraculous with the appearance of the spring of healing waters in Lourdes that bring healing to this day. And again, in 1917, Mary would appear to three little shepherds in Fatima, Portugal, to bring a message about God's plan for world peace through the rosary, prayer and sacrifice. During Mary' sixth visit to the children, God and Mary would work another miracle with the dramatic "dance" of the sun on October 13, 1917.

Using miracles to initiate and deepen faith is regularly a part of God's work of bringing the Gospel of God's love and mercy. Jesus worked miracles to help the people of His time to believe in God's work of salvation. And in the three stories of Mary's apparitions mentioned above, the stories of Guadalupe, Lourdes and Fatima, we can see how God used the miraculous to help people to believe. The methods of Jesus, of Mary and of other evangelists are very similar. God's demonstrations of love help people of all times and places to believe in His love for us.

FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT



"And they shall remain, for now his greatness shall reach to the ends of the earth; he shall be peace... Micah the prophet tells us the Lord is reaching out to us. We are now at the edge, recalling the great event of salvation, as He comes to us. Advent draws to a close as we celebrate the Savior's birth. But wait!

We meet the third critical person of advent in Mary's visitation to Elizabeth. How frequently we pray the *Hail Mary*, but do we realize we are reciting the very words of scripture? Our prayer is quoting the gospel of Luke. The question of Mary's relative can be ours today – 'Who am I that the mother of my Lord should come to me?' On this eve of Christmas may I ask, "Who am I that the Savior should come to me?" The answer - I am loved, chosen and blessed by God with those around me. Come Lord Jesus.
