St. Lawrence Church continues to support the diocesan wide Pre-School Food Pack Program which provides needy pre-school children of the El Mundo Del Nino School in Paterson with a supply of healthy food and snacks and a meal for families. The families appreciate our support.

This year we are asked to provide 100 food packs that will be delivered to Paterson by Friday, February 16.

A typical food pack for each child includes:

- **2 breakfast items** (instant oatmeal pack) [200 needed]
- **2 lunch items** (Chef Boyardee Micro Meal Beefaroni, Kraft Easy Pack Mac & Cheese) [200 needed]
- 1 milk (Horizon White Milk) [100 needed]
- 1 Apple and Eve 100% apple juice [100 needed]
- 1 fruit cup (diced peaches, Mandarin orange segments, apple sauce) [100 needed]
- 2 snacks (Rice Krispie Treat, soft and chewy granola bars) [200 needed]
- 1 meal to share with family (16 oz. bag white rice, 5 oz. can tuna, 16 oz. bag dry black beans) [100 rice or beans needed / 100 cans of tuna needed]

Please stick to these items above. The food packs will be assembled by the Good Samaritans on Monday, February 12.


