FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

FATIMA, THE ROSARY AND MARIAN CONSECRATION



On May 13th of 1917, Our Blessed Mother appeared to three young shepherds in Fatima, Portugal. She would visit them monthly from May through October of that year. She would form them spiritually and would teach them how to pray and sacrifice for peace. She would ask the children to bring this message to the world.

This coming week, on Tuesday, February 27th at 7 pm and on Saturday, March 2nd at 9 am, David Carollo, executive director of the Blue Army in Washington, NJ, will teach us about the message of Mary at Fatima, which is Heaven's Plan for World Peace. It will be the same teaching on both Tuesday and Saturday. I hope you and your family can join us for one or the other of the talks. I hope to see you then!

THE EUCHARIST AND THE NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL



Back in 2019, the Pew Research Center surveyed self-described American Catholics about their belief in the nature of the Eucharist. Most of these stated that they did not believe that the Eucharist is truly the body and blood of Jesus. Less than 30 percent of those surveyed believed that the bread and wine become the flesh and the blood of Jesus during the Mass. Instead, they said they believed that the bread and wine are simply symbols for the body and blood of Jesus, which is what most Protestants believe. The change of the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus is described by the expression "Transubstantiation."

In response to this shocking survey, the Catholic Church in the United States initiated a three-year process of revival for all of the Catholics in the US. This revival aims to deepen our faith and devotion in the real presence of Jesus in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. This time of revival began on the Feast of Corpus Christ in 2022 which was celebrated on June 19, 2022.

We see this time of revival as an invitation from Jesus himself to come and believe more deeply. The first year of the revival was a year of study, prayer and fasting. It was a time of discernment and planning. The second year is a time of prayer and action in the parishes of our country. We are currently in this second year.

What are we doing at St. Lawrence Church to participate in this Revival? At the suggestion of one of parishioners, we began a weekly 24 hours of Eucharistic Adoration in Lent of 2022. We began with a reading of Lucia Picarretta's reflection on the Passion of the Lord during that Lent, hence the placement of our adoration during the hours of Jesus' Passion (Holy Thursday evening to Good Friday afternoon). We have continued the weekly Adoration since that time.

More recently, in December of 2023, we invited and hosted the Array of Hope Ministry for a three-night mission for Eucharistic Revival. The mission was called "Behold: A Three Night Encounter with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament." The Mission gave us quality teachings and times for prayer and worship of our Eucharistic Lord. I am most grateful to our parishioners for their attendance at that mission.

On Tuesday, March 12th at 7 pm, we will have a Eucharistic video night for reflection and discussion in our Church Hall. We will listen to an outstanding teaching by one of the national preachers of the Eucharistic Revival. I hope you can join us for that night.




