

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

THE NECESSITY OF FORGIVENESS



Jesus placed a great emphasis on forgiveness. When He gave us His prayer, the Lord's Prayer, He said, "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." Clearly here, Jesus is saying God's forgiveness is dependent on our forgiving others. In another place in the Gospels, Jesus said similarly, "If you forgive others' sins, your heavenly Father will forgive you yours. If you do not forgive others their sins, neither will your Father forgive you yours."

In addition, Jesus presented us with a parable about a man who owed a huge debt and is forgiven by his employer and then refuses to forgive a fellow worker who owes a much smaller amount.

Jesus is telling us that it is absolutely essential that we forgive others. I recently heard a Catholic teacher explain that the refusal to forgive makes our hearts hard. The choice to forgive requires that we choose love and love softens the heart. Our hearts are meant to be soft and are made for love.

In Jesus' parable about the man who is forgiven and then refuses to forgive his neighbor also reveals the man's choice of money over his neighbor. Love of money is idolatry. Money is a false god. St. Paul wrote to Timothy that the love of money is the root of all evil. Jesus also said that you cannot serve both God and Mammon. Mammon is the Syrian god of riches. God calls us to love both Himself and our neighbors, not money.

WEEKLY ADORATION

During Lent, we are called to observe acts of fasting and abstinence as well as acts of denial. But the Church also calls on us to take positive actions, such as prayer, attending daily Mass, or attending Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

An Hour with the Lord

The Catholic Church has a tradition of spending "Holy Hour" with Jesus meditating on His sufferings in the Garden of Gethsemane. We honor and console His heart when we "stay awake" with Him and spend an hour in prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. Although it can take place at any hour, Thursday or Friday is the preferred time because of the link to Christ's Passion. The Lord longs for us and our company more than we long for Him.

St. Lawrence Church invites you to visit Jesus during our Eucharistic Adoration every Thursday through Friday. The Adoration starts at 5 PM and continues until Friday at 5 PM. While anyone can come at any time during Adoration, we need volunteers to fill all the time slots so that our Lord will be accompanied throughout the period. This is especially important for the night hours from Thursday night to Friday morning. Spending time in quiet Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament could be a great Lenten sacrifice.
