### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### A LESSON FROM THE CURSILLO MOVEMENT



Back in the 1950's, the Catholic Church in Spain started a process to deepen the faith of her people. They called it, "Cursillo de la Cristiandad", which translates to a Short Course in Christianity. This three-day retreat included community time to build fraternity, several lessons about the Christian life as well as prayer time where one could "bond" with Jesus himself. One of the lessons was about the priorities of the Christian life. The top priority for a Christian is to deepen his bond with Jesus. The second was to love one's spouse. The third was to love one's children and grandchildren. The fourth was to work to support the family. And the fifth was to get involved in other activities such as helping those in need.

A little about the first priority of the Christin life, to bond with Jesus. How do we make that happen? Simply put, we need to spend time with Jesus to bond with Him. How and where can we do that? We bond with Jesus by meeting with Him in the sacraments including the Eucharist and Reconciliation. We also bond with Him by spending time in conversation with Him every day. Spending time with Jesus affects for the better all the other priorities that we have in the Christian life.
