DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY



Today is Divine Mercy Sunday. Our Lord Jesus is rich in mercy. Today He wishes to grant a plenary indulgence. The conditions for this gift are: "under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff), (the plenary indulgence is granted) to all the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!")."

We will have a service today in church at 2:30 pm to honor the Divine Mercy. Our service will include adoration, the chaplet of Divine Mercy, and benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. We will also reverence a first class relic of St. Faustina Kowalska. You are most welcome to attend.

TWO DAILY MASSES

Please be aware that on weekdays we have two Masses each day, at 8 am and at 9 am. In the Eucharist, we have a deep encounter with Jesus himself. We hear and our faith is fed by His life-giving Word and we are joined to Him in the great sacrifice of the Mass and in the time of Holy Communion. This contact with Jesus, this closeness with Him, this experience of His love, changes us for the better. At Mass, we are in contact with His grace and that contact, if we are open to Him, makes us grow in the image of His love. Why not join us for weekday Mass even if it is just once a week?

MORNING PRAYER

Please be aware that we offer morning prayer in common on weekdays at 7:30 am in our chapel. You are most welcome to join us. We will help you to learn this beautiful form of prayer.
