FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

THE UNIQUE CHARACTER OF EACH SACRAMENT



During the holy season of Easter, we recall that Jesus has risen from the dead. He is alive! In His resurrection, He has conquered sin and death. And He is here for us, especially in the seven sacraments.

The name, sacrament, means the "mystery." Mystery or sacrament is the term that Church has traditionally used for the presence of the risen Lord Jesus. That is why the priest will often remind us that Jesus is truly present when we meet to celebrate a sacrament.

As Catholics, we celebrate seven sacraments. In each of the sacraments, Jesus ministers to us in a particular way. In Baptism, we are immersed in the waters as we repent of our sins and receive the forgiveness of God. In Baptism, we are also immersed in the Holy Spirit of Jesus, who sanctifies us, heals us, strengthens us, teaches us, and guides us. In this sacrament, we believe that we are baptized in water and the Spirit.

In **Baptism**, we receive forgiveness of sins. However, we only celebrate Baptism one time in our lives. When we sin later in our lives, we meet with Jesus in the sacrament of **Reconciliation** or confession. In this sacrament, we repent of our sins and we receive forgiveness, peace, and the graces that we need to overcome our particular sins. For example, if my sin is pride, Jesus will help me to be more humble in this sacrament. If my sin is judgment or calumny, Jesus will increase my concern for the well-being and the reputation of another. If my sin is impurity, Jesus will help me to hate that sin and learn to be more respectful of the opposite sex. The graces of this sacrament are often overlooked. Confession is also a healing sacrament. Jesus heals many people in various ways through the power of this sacrament.

In Confirmation, we receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit. We receive the Holy Spirit for the first time in Baptism. In Confirmation, we receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit in a way similar to the way that the Apostles received the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. The gifts of the Spirit help us to minister to others so that they may grow in faith, hope and love.

In the Sacrament of the **Eucharist**, Jesus also ministers to us. He ministers to us with His Word. He ministers to us with the Sacrament of His Body. With the Sacrament of His Body, He makes present His flesh and blood that He offered for us upon the cross. There is great power and healing that flows from the cross of Jesus. In Holy Communion, He also gives us His flesh as a special food that touches and transforms our hearts. The flesh of Jesus is our food for our journey to the Kingdom of God.

When we are not well, Jesus ministers to us with the Sacrament of the **Anointing of the Sick**. This is a sacrament of healing, comfort and strength.

In the Sacrament of **Holy Matrimony**, Jesus is present in the union of two baptized persons, a man and a woman, who bring the love of Jesus to each other, to their children and grandchildren and to others, too. When a man and a woman of faith love each other deeply, they are acting and living in the image and the likeness of God.

In the Sacrament of **Holy Orders**, men bring us the presence of Jesus the Good Shepherd. Bishops, priests and deacons act in the name of Jesus. Bishops and priests preach and bring us all of the sacraments. Deacons serve us in many ways including preaching, witnessing weddings, baptizing, assisting at funerals and burials, and many other ways, always in humble and loving service.




