FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



THE CONCLAVE WHAT IS IT ABOUT?

Many people are talking about the conclave of the Catholic cardinals these days. Hollywood created a movie to give an imaginary representation of what a conclave is like. It showed the obvious thoughts and preferences of Hollywood types. How could anyone expect them to know what a conclave is?

On social media, various groups are presenting images of individual cardinals with the obvious intent of influencing public opinion as to which cardinals match their world views and their political positions. They are building up some cardinals and tearing others down. I recently heard a comment by retired Cardinal Sean O'Malley, former archbishop of Boston and a confidant of Pope Francis, who said that a conclave is like a religious retreat, attended by the cardinals, with the mission of seeking God's help in selecting a leader for the Catholic Church. Because so few of the cardinals know each other personally, a necessary step at the conclave will be for the cardinals to get to know one another. The cardinals will pray together to discern the will of God for the Church.

Archbishop Cordileone of San Francisco recently made an interesting observation. He said that knowledge of how the new pope views the liturgy will be a critical piece of the meeting because worship of God and all of the sacraments are so central to the life of the Church and all of her members. There is much tension in the Church about how Mass should be celebrated. We all need to pray that the cardinals will seek God's light during this process.

Clearly, we need a cardinal who is like Jesus . . . humble, gentle, wise, faithful to the Word of God, a man of prayer, a lover of peace, a lover of the poor, universal in his love for the human family. I am thinking that we should have a special day of adoration at St. Lawrence Church dedicated to prayer for the Catholic Church and for the papal selection process! Hopefully we can have that day before you read this article.
