ENOUGH LIGHT FOR ONE STEP



Last week, I attended the end of year dinner for our parish adult choir. One choir member shared with us a helpful lesson that she heard from Father Mike Schmitz. Father Mike gave a teaching that as we seek to do the will of God, God only gives us enough light to be able to see enough to take our next step. The light that God gives us does not allow us to see beyond that one step. As the song says, "We walk by faith and not by sight."

Faith involves a trust in God that if we are true to God's word, we will do fine and will be provided for. God will not abandon us. He is with us. He is Emmanuel, which means God is with us.

PARENTS TEACHING THEIR CHILDREN TO OBEY THE LORD AND TO TRUST IN HIM

I find great solace in the following saying of Jesus. "Seek first the Kingdom of God and everything else will be given you besides." In the Kingdom of God, Jesus is the Lord. When Jesus says that we should seek the Kingdom of God, He means that we should seek to do His will at all times. One way that we can find the will of God is to learn His commandments and to keep His commandments. "If you love Me, keep My commandments."

It saddens me that some parents do not teach their children to make doing God's will and keeping the commandments a priority. In speaking to some of our children about keeping the commandments, they responded that they keep the commandments, like the obligation that we have to attend Mass on Sundays, "when they can." This answer says to me that the children are being taught to give priority to other things over God's will. This is a mistake. Keeping the commandments brings good into all of our lives. Let's not deny our children all the good that God's Word can bring us.




