FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

POPE LEO AND OUR LADY OF GRACE



With God there are no coincidences. Sometimes God uses details and coincidences to get our attention and to teach us lessons. Recently, there was a special message from heaven on the day of the election of Pope Leo XIV. As you may know, Pope Leo is an Augustinian priest. He did his undergraduate studies in mathematics at Villanova University, an Augustinian school. Most religious communities have a devotion to the Blessed Mother under a particular title of hers. The Augustinians have a devotion to Mary as Our Lady of Grace. The Augustinians honor Our Lady of Grace on May 8th. By God's design, Robert Francis Prevost was elected our new Holy Father, on the Augustinian Feast of Our Lady of Grace, May 8th. Is this just a coincidence? I do not think so.

I would like to say a little more about Our Lady of Grace. In this image, Mary has her hands extended to the earth with rays of grace radiating from some of her fingers. Someone once asked her why there were not rays extending from all of her fingers. Mary replied that there were fingers without rays because they represented graces that people had not prayed for. We need to ask for God's graces. Jesus said, "Ask and you shall receive."

I truly believe that Our Blessed Mother had a hand in the election of Pope Leo. In the matter of world history, Mary has said that in the end, her Immaculate Heart will triumph! It is comforting that we can see Mary's hand in the care of the Catholic Church.

A PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS

"At that time Jesus appointed seventy-two others whom He sent ahead of Him in pairs to every town and place He intended to visit. He said, 'The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few, so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest. Go on your way; behold I am sending you like lambs among wolves.' "

As I read the gospel passage, I realize that the seventy-two were not sufficient to complete the mission. It was only the beginning. We might think a missionary is one who joins a group and is sent to bring the good news of Jesus to another region or country. That is a limited understanding of the role of a catholic.

Because of my baptism my name is added to the seventy-two, as I am commissioned to go on mission. Why? The harvest is ready but as long as I just sit on the sidelines and watch, I am allowing the wolves to devour the sheep. Are you ready to be recommissioned? Pope Saint John Paul II told us "the mission of Christ the redeemer which He entrusted to His church is far from completion." Make it 73?
