FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

CONVERSATION WITH GOD



Gods created us. God created everything. Sometimes when we think of God's creation, we think only of objects or plants or people that we can see and feel and touch. But God created everything, including how persons relate to each other. He created how we relate as people and He created how we relate to Him.

God's design for relationships is that if we put in the time we can build relationships and that if we do not put in the time, our relationships will stall or regress. This is true of relationships between human beings and also between persons and God. People need conversations with others and we need conversations with God. This is how we build relationships with others. Through our conversations with God, we build our relationship with Him.

Conversation involves speaking and listening. Both parties need time to speak and to listen. This is true in our relationship with God. The Church and the saints recommend that we use the Bible when we pray. The Bible is without a doubt the Word of God. I recommend that we use the readings from the daily Mass as a tool for our conversations with God. We need to take time to pray every day. Thus we will know Him better and also understand His will and His plan for creation better. It is essential that we take time for prayer every day!




