FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

LOVE, HOLINESS AND THE SACRAMENTS



Jesus teaches us, "Be holy as my Father is holy." It is a beautiful calling that God is making to all of us. "Be Holy." What does it mean to be holy? The Church in her wisdom teaches us that holiness is love. The more a person loves, the more he or she is holy. A fair question is, "Can a person grow in love?" The answer is YES. Then, how can we grow to love more? The answer is that with God's help, we can grow to love more.

It is by meeting with Jesus regularly in the sacraments that we can grow to love more and better. All of the seven sacramenta can help us to love more. In particular, the Sacraments of the Eucharist and Reconciliation help us to grow in love. The more frequently we celebrate these two sacraments, the more we will grow in love. The Eucharist is our food for the journey of life. The Eucharist helps us to grow in union with God. The Eucharist brings us into contact with the Heart of Jesus and His heart changes our hearts. The Sacrament of Reconciliation helps us to remove our sins and faults that separate us from the love of God and weaken the love of God in our hearts and in our lives. If we want to grow in love and holiness, then we must meet with Jesus often in the Sacraments of the Eucharist and Reconciliation. According to the commandments, we must attend Mass every Sunday. Those intent on growing in holiness come to weekday Masses, too. St. John Paul II said that confession once a month is a good rate for most Catholics. Our Lady of Medjugorje recommends confession once a month, too.


