Students in Grades 2 and 3 are Using Reflex© Math Fact Fluency

Mrs. Bonneau, grade 3, and Miss Krause, grade 2, were awarded a grant from Reflex© Math to use in their classrooms this year! This program allows the teachers to track students' fluency and the improvements they make with their math facts. Reflex is an interactive, online program that takes the students on an exciting math journey with their avatar. They unlock series of games and aim to hit the green light each day! Grade 3 has already solved 19,000 facts and Grade 2 has solved 13,000! Both grades are very excited to become more confident and fluent mathematicians with the help of Reflex.



Grade 1 Students Are Scientists!

In grade 1 we are learning to be scientists that observe, ask questions, and find answers about our world. Utilizing the new *Nancy Larson Science* program, we are learning about the life stages of humans and how humans develop.

The *Nancy Larson Science* program is taught in grades k-5 and encourages inquiry and exploration and also provides challenging and engaging content through experiments and hands-on activities.



In our reading series, *Journeys*, we are learning about different kinds of storms. We studied how storms form and the tools meteorologists use to measure strong winds, heavy rains, and temperature.
