Our class will be focusing on the four seasons and how they are different. Children will also be reading stories and poems about the weather in each season.

**Vocabulary: weather, seasons** Discuss the four seasons and describe how the weather is similar or different, depending on where you live. Then invite your child to draw a picture of each season.

**High-Frequency Words: is, little** Write the words is and little on paper, then have your child do the same. Describe the weather you see outside today. Use the words is and little and record them on paper.

Category Words: seasons Display some of the clothing that your child wears in each of the four seasons. Ask your child to identify the season during which the clothing is worn.

**Phonics:** b, I Invite your child to search for objects that begin with the letter b and the letter I. Write the

names of the objects on sticky notes. Have your child stick the labels on each item.

**Comprehension: Sequence** Read a story. Ask your child what happens in the beginning, middle, and end of the story.

In math, comparing numbers 1-12, using the terms less than, equal to, and greater than will be the focus. We will also be ordering the numbers 1-12, using the terms before, after, and between.

The religion lesson is "Jesus Teaches and Helps Us." We will discuss that Jesus went everywhere teaching and helping people. Jesus was kind and good.

**Celebration!** As of today, Friday, February 14<sup>th</sup>, is the **hundredth day of school**. Ten bundles of ten will be the straw count for the day! Everyone has been anticipating this event for weeks, and finally it is almost here! Please refer to the separate note that will be going home on Monday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>. During the morning, each child will be able to present his or her **100<sup>th</sup> Day project**. It is an exciting activity, and the children enjoy showing the class their work.
