PRINCIPAL'S NOVEMBER MESSAGE

Dear Saint Cecilia Families,

November is the month of gratitude, and I want to begin by saying how truly thankful I am for each of you. Our families, students, and staff always go above and beyond to make Saint Cecilia School feel like one big family. Your continued support, kindness, and commitment to our school community are what make this such a special place.

Over the past several months, we have been hard at work implementing our new Student Information System through FACTS. Coincidentally, this same system will be required for all Catholic schools in Rhode Island beginning in April — but I'm proud to share that we're already ahead of the game! The process was far from easy, and I don't think I realized how challenging this conversion would be. There were many long days throughout the summer (some over 10 hours!) filled with trial and error.

It truly takes a village—and thanks to the support of **Father Steve**, **our amazing teachers** and our incredible front office staff, we made it happen! A very special thank you to **Rachel Faria**, **Sarah Collins**, **and Deana San Souci** for their countless hours of patience and teamwork. Because of their efforts, the **admissions process will open on time** and will be managed directly through FACTS in just a few months. **Financial aid applications** will also open soon, and families will receive updates and awards directly through FACTS by late March or early April.

The best part? There will be no more large manila folders or endless paperwork! While we're still working out a few minor bugs, I'm confident our team has this process down. All additional billing will now be invoiced separately from tuition, which allows you to manage payments directly through your account, and helps us better plan and budget for future years.

Behind the scenes, I've been working on several important projects. Although I miss being outside for morning drop-off, I'm currently covering Morning Care each day and focusing on updating our School Safety Plan, which I'll be sharing with families soon. I've also been collaborating with another Catholic school in Massachusetts that has successfully received over \$3 million in safety and security grants. With their guidance, I'm preparing a grant proposal for new front and back doors, a key fob entry system, fencing, and new windows for our building. Researching and writing grants is time-consuming, but I'm hopeful that we'll be able to secure funds to make these important improvements.

In just a few short months, we've already accomplished and celebrated so much — from our **Cross Country season** and the visit from **Bishop Bruce**, to **two successful PTO events**, and the launch of **Drama Club**, **Cheerleading**, **and Basketball**. And of course, we can't forget being featured on **Channel 12 News** for our Friday Report! What we do here at Saint Cecilia is truly special, and it's wonderful when our school community is recognized.

We've also been blessed with **Mr. Bob**, who has been a tremendous addition to our team. He has worked tirelessly to get our **heating system** running smoothly and even repaired several classroom windows. We also have a **brand new fire box** and **updated smoke detectors** installed throughout the building — a huge step forward for safety. Fun fact: two of the state fire marshals who recently visited are alumni of Saint Cecilia School! They loved walking through the halls and reminiscing about their time here.

I also want to thank **Officer Rose** for assisting with morning drop-off and ensuring our families feel safe each day. It's heartwarming to see so many members of our community looking out for our school.

As the **first trimester** comes to a close, a reminder that **Parent-Teacher Conference sign-ups** will be sent out on **December 1st**. Conferences will take place from **8:00** a.m. to **3:00** p.m., and it will be a **distance learning day** for students. This schedule allows teachers to focus entirely on meeting with parents to discuss student progress. For families who may need childcare during their conference time, I'll happily keep an eye on your child in the office during your meeting.

Looking ahead, our Christmas Pageant will be held on Monday, December 15th in the evening — more details to come soon!

And finally, our **Fall Fundraiser**, **"Rake in the Cash,"** is in full swing! I can't wait to see our milestone markers next week. Every dollar raised goes directly toward our students, so let's make this fundraiser one to remember. Check your child's folder for details — we have several fun surprises planned for each milestone we reach!

Thank you, as always, for your unwavering support, generosity, and love for Saint Cecilia School. Together, we make this an incredible place to learn, grow, and share in faith.

Morning Drop Off

7:45: Doors open for arrival (Back doors)

Pre-K enters through the Pre-K back door.

Kindergarten enters through the kindergarten back door

1st, 2nd, and 3rd graders enter through the back door closest to their classroom.

Middle School enters the back door closest to the kindergarten classroom, and proceeds directly to their homeroom.

Afternoon Pick Up

- **For Pre-K students who are half-day, dismissal is at 11:00 a.m. at the front doors of the school.
- **Pre-K and Kindergarten dismissal time is 2:00 p.m out the back doors.
- **Grades 1-5 dismissal time is 2:05pm out the back doors.
- **Grades 6-8 dismissal time is 2:10pm out the front doors of the school. If a Middle School student has a younger sibling, they may exit out the back doors.
- **Bus students will wait in the main hall downstairs for the bus to arrive.

Morning & Extended Care

We are once again offering Morning Care and Extended Care this school year, staffed by our own Saint Cecilia faculty and staff. These programs are available for both regular use and as a drop-in option.

Morning Care: Perfect for families needing an earlier start.

The cost is \$8.25 per student (\$7.25 per student if siblings attend together)

Extended Care: Helpful if you are running late or need coverage after school. The cost is \$8.25 per student per hour (\$7.25 per student per hour if siblings attend together) If you would like your child(ren) to attend, please email your child's teacher and myself.

Families will be billed bi-weekly directly through FACTS Please make sure to check your accounts regularly.
