

Middle School Supplies: Social Studies (6 - 8), Math (6 - 8)

Quantity	Social Studies
1	3 Ring Binder. This is needed to store any handouts I give you in class and to keep yourself organized
Determinant	Loose leaf paper. Note taking will be done in this class and paper will be needed to do so. Paper can be stored in a student's 3 ring binders. Paper may need to be refilled by parents as the year goes on.
1	Folder for handouts. Some things I give students may not be hole punched so a folder is needed to hold onto those. Folders can then be kept in their binders
1	Box of # 2 pencils and erasers. Should be kept in some form of pencil case or their locker to avoid losing them all.
1	Box of colored pencils for when we color maps or other coloring activities.
1	Tube of clorox wipes. Everybody will get messy at some point this year, so everyone should bring wipes that will be stored together.
1	Box of tissues, everybody will get a stuffy nose at some point this year. I will collect tissues at the start of the year and keep them for students to use as the year progresses.
2	Stacks of index cards. Will be used throughout the year

Quantity	Math
1	Calculator. Students will need a calculator to solve complex math problems. Please ensure that you have a fully functional calculator. A TI - 108 should do fine.
