Happy Sunday to All ! On Trinity Sunday 1895, St. Therese of the Child Jesus receives the inspiration to offer herself to the Merciful Love of God. After her death as a young woman, a prayer she wrote to commemorate that gift was found in the pages of her Bible. Here is a section of that prayer. May Therese inspire our parishioner to a deep and sacrificial love for God and one another...

O my God! O Most Blessed Trinity! I desire to love You and to make You loved—to labor for the glory of Holy Church by saving souls here upon earth and by delivering those suffering in purgatory. I desire to fulfill perfectly Your Holy Will and to reach the degree of glory You have prepared for me in Your Kingdom. In a word, I wish to be holy, but, knowing how helpless I am, I beseech You, my God, to be Yourself my holiness...
In order that my life may be one Act of perfect Love, I offer myself as a Victim of Holocaust to Your Merciful Love, imploring You to consume me unceasingly, and to allow the floods of infinite tenderness gathered up in You to overflow in my soul, so that I may become a very martyr of Your Love, O my God!

Here are some more memories from Former Pastor Fr. Al Krzyzopolski: "I came to St Therese in 1977... We also had charge of the Brandon parish in its infancy. There was no catholic church building there yet, so we held Sunday services at Protestant churches and rented space for the religious education of the children of that growing town. The spirit of the people (at St. Therese) who supported the parish family was one of the best I have encountered in my many years as a pastor. All too soon I was transferred to the Cathedral after serving St Therese for less than two years. But many pleasant memories linger and are very precious reminders of happy days of long ago."
