



THE GOOD NEWS

Scott Hahn Reflects on Ascension Sunday

In today's First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles, St. Luke gives the surprising news that there is more of the story to be told. The story did not end with the empty tomb, or with Jesus' appearances to the Apostles over the course of forty days. Jesus' saving work will have a liturgical consummation. He is the great high priest, and He has still to ascend to the heavenly Jerusalem, there to celebrate the feast in the true Holy of Holies.

The truth of this feast shines forth from the Letter to the Hebrews, where we read of the great high priest's passing through the heavens, the sinless intercessor's sacrifice on our behalf (see Hebrews 4:14-15).

Indeed, His intercession will lead to the Holy Spirit's descent in fire upon the Church. Luke spells out that promise in the First Reading for the feast of the Ascension: "in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit" (Acts 1:5). The Ascension is the preliminary feast that directs the Church's attention forward to Pentecost. On that day, salvation will be complete; for salvation is not simply expiation for sins (that would be wonder enough), but it is something even greater than that. Expiation is itself a necessary precondition of our adoption as God's children. To live that divine life we must receive the Holy Spirit. To receive the Holy Spirit we must be purified through Baptism.

The Responsorial Psalm presents the Ascension in terms familiar from the worship of the Jerusalem Temple in the days of King Solomon: "God mounts his throne to shouts of joy: a blare of trumpets for the Lord" (Psalm 47). The priest-king takes his place at the head of the people, ruling over the nations, establishing peace.

The Epistle strikes a distinctively Paschal note. In the early Church, as today, Easter was the normal time for the baptism of adult converts. The sacrament was often called "illumination" or "enlightenment" because of the light that came with God's saving grace (see, for example, Hebrews 10:32). Saint Paul, in his Letter to the Ephesians, speaks in terms of glory that leads to greater glories still, as Ascension leads to Pentecost: "May the eyes of your hearts be enlightened," he writes, as he looks to the divinization of the believers. Their "hope" is "his inheritance among the holy ones," the saints who have been adopted into God's family and now rule with Him at the Father's right hand.

This is the good news: the Apostles are commissioned to spread to the whole world, to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem—at the Ascension. It's the good news we must spread today.

CATECHISM of the Catholic Church

In ascending into Heaven Body and Soul, his humanity entered into divine glory; we will also have a share in that glory in our own resurrection at the end of time.

§659 "So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God." Christ's body was glorified at the moment of his Resurrection, as proved by the new and supernatural properties it subsequently and permanently enjoys. But during the forty days when he eats and drinks familiarly with his disciples and teaches them about the kingdom, his glory remains veiled under the appearance of ordinary humanity. Jesus' final apparition ends with the irreversible entry of his humanity into divine glory, symbolized by the cloud and by heaven, where he is seated from that time forward at God's right hand. Only in a wholly exceptional and unique way would Jesus show himself to Paul "as to one untimely born", in a last apparition that established him as an apostle.

LA BUENA NUEVA

Dr. Hahn reflexiona sobre la Ascensión del Señor

En la primera lectura de hoy de los Hechos de los apóstoles, San Lucas nos da las maravillosas noticias que todavía hay más que contar de esta historia. No terminó todo con la tumba vacía, o con la aparición de Jesús a los apóstoles durante esos 40 días. La obra salvífica de Jesús tendría una consumación litúrgica. Es el sumo sacerdote que todavía tiene que ascender a la Jerusalén celestial, para celebrar la fiesta en el Santísimo de los cielos.

La verdad de esta fiesta resalta en la carta a los Hebreos, donde leemos que el sumo sacerdote penetró los cielos, el sacrificio del intercesor sin pecado por nuestra causa (véase Hebreos 4, 14-15).

Efectivamente, esta intercesión permite la venida del Espíritu Santo en forma de fuego sobre la Iglesia. Lucas detalla esta promesa en la primera lectura de la Ascensión: "dentro de pocos días ustedes serán bautizados con el Espíritu Santo" (Hechos 1,5). La Ascensión es la fiesta que orienta a la Iglesia hacia el Pentecostés. En ese día, se completó la salvación; pues la salvación no es simplemente la expiación de los pecados (que fuera más que suficiente), pero es algo más aun. La expiación es algo necesario para nuestra adopción como hijos de Dios. Para vivir esta vida divina hay que recibir el Espíritu Santo. Para recibir el Espíritu Santo hay que ser purificados por el bautismo. El salmo responsorial nos presenta la Ascensión en términos conocidos del culto del Templo de Jerusalén en los días del Rey Salomón: "Entre voces de júbilo y trompetas, Dios asciende a su trono" (Salmo 47). El sacerdote-rey toma el lugar principal sobre su pueblo, gobernando a las naciones, estableciendo la paz.

La epístola toma un tono algo pascual. En la Iglesia naciente, al igual que hoy, la Pascua era la temporada de bautismos de conversos ya adultos. Se le decía a este sacramento "la iluminación" (véase Hebreos 10,32) por la luz que conlleva la gracia salvadora de Dios. San Pablo, en su carta a los efesios, hace referencia a la gloria que lleva a glorias aun mayores, así como la Ascensión lleva al Pentecostés: "Le pido que les ilumine la mente" al esperar la divinización de los creyentes. Su "esperanza" es "la herencia que Dios da a los que son suyos," los santos que han sido adoptados a la familia de Dios y que ahora gobiernan con él a la derecha del Padre.

Esta es la "buena nueva" a la que los apóstoles se les encomienda compartir al mundo entero, a todos los pueblos, comenzando con Jerusalén, en la primera Ascensión. Es la buena nueva que tenemos que compartir hoy.

CATECISMO de la Iglesia Católica

Al subir al Cielo en Cuerpo y Alma, su humanidad entró en la gloria divina; también tendremos una participación en esa gloria en nuestra propia resurrección al final de los tiempos.

§659 "Con esto, el Señor Jesús, después de hablarles, fue elevado al Cielo y se sentó a la diestra de Dios" (Mc 16, 19). El Cuerpo de Cristo fue glorificado desde el instante de su Resurrección como lo prueban las propiedades nuevas y sobrenaturales, de las que desde entonces su cuerpo disfruta para siempre (cf. Lc 24, 31; Jn 20, 19. 26). Pero durante los cuarenta días en los que él come y bebe familiarmente con sus discípulos (cf. Hch 10, 41) y les instruye sobre el Reino (cf. Hch 1, 3), su gloria aún queda velada bajo los rasgos de una humanidad ordinaria (cf. Mc 16,12; Lc 24, 15; Jn 20, 14-15; 21, 4). La última aparición de Jesús termina con la entrada irreversible de su humanidad en la gloria divina simbolizada por la nube (cf. Hch 1, 9; cf. también Lc 9, 34-35; Ex 13, 22) y por el cielo (cf. Lc 24, 51) donde él se sienta para siempre a la derecha de Dios (cf. Mc 16, 19; Hch 2, 33; 7, 56; cf. también Sal 110, 1). Sólo de manera completamente excepcional y única, se muestra a Pablo "como un abortivo" (1 Co 15, 8) en una última aparición que constituye a éste en apóstol (cf. 1 Co 9, 1; Ga 1, 16).






