

Learn ~ Aprender

Deacon Jose Moronta

We will hear about great miracles of Jesus in the coming Sundays

Once we are back to the Ordinary Time, the gospel passages come as a succession of narratives, bringing us the opportunity to walk along the book composed by our patron saint, Mark the Evangelist. As we walk with Jesus through His public ministry during the period of Ordinary Time, we find ourselves on the western shore of the Sea of Galilee.

Jesus has just completed His teaching of the parable of the mustard seed. What we will hear today is the first of three miraculous actions: 1) The stilling of the storm (Mark 4:35-40), 2) Exorcising a demon (Mark 5:1-20), and 3) Healing the sick (Mark 5:21-43)

This is what we have for today's gospel reading:

«On that day, as evening drew on, he said to them, "Let us cross to the other side." Leaving the crowd, they took him with them in the boat just as he was... A violent squall came up and waves were breaking over the boat, so that it was already filling up. Jesus was in the stern, asleep on a cushion. They woke him and said to him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" He woke up, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Quiet! Be still!" The wind ceased and there was great calm...»

Recalling this episode (the calming of the storm) must have often helped the apostles during their struggles. We are all one body with Jesus as the head – we can overcome even what appear to be insurmountable obstacles. Life is like a boat, exposed to a myriad of dangers; temptations, occasions to sin, bad counsels of men, passions of corrupt nature, etc. Never lose confidence – when temptations arise, keep your eyes on God, who alone can deliver us.

Let us read what Saint Augustine wrote about this episode:

"When you have to listen to abuse, that means you are being buffeted by the wind. When your anger is roused, you are being tossed by the waves. So when the winds blow and the waves mount high, the boat is in danger, your heart is imperiled, your heart is taking a battering. On hearing yourself insulted, you long to retaliate; but the joy of revenge brings with it another kind of misfortune –

Diocese of St. Petersburg - APA & Forward in Faith

What is the Annual Pastoral Appeal (APA)?

Each year, all of the parishes in the Diocese of St. Petersburg are accessed roughly 13% of their combined parish revenues (offertory collections) to fund the operating budget of our diocesan level ministries and services which serve its five counties.

The Annual Pastoral Appeal (APA), managed by the Diocese of St. Petersburg, is the annual fundraiser or appeal initiated in January by a mailing pledge cards to all of the parishioners of each parish inviting them to contribute directly toward helping their specific parish pay its yearly APA required assessment.

The requirement is for each parish to reach their assessment amount (*optimally through pledge contributions or one time donations*).

However, **if the goal is not met, the balance due must be paid out of the parish's operating funds** (which are the offertory collections which fund their operating budgets).

Tax Free Contribution Information

If you are over 70 ½ and have an IRA or similar retirement account you may be required to take annual distributions prescribed by the IRS. These distributions are usually taxed at your ordinary income tax rate.

A new law was passed on 12/15/2015 which may allow you to contribute any part of your IRA including these required distributions to St. Mark TAX FREE!

Example: If you contribute \$5000 from your IRA to St. Mark and are in a 20% tax bracket, the church receives the \$5000 and you may save \$1000 in taxes.

A WIN-WIN for both the church and the parishioner!

If your tax advisor agrees and you want to contribute from your 2021 required annual distribution or even from your current IRA,

instruct your IRA custodian to make the check out to: St. Mark the Evangelist Catholic Church.

They can either send it to you or directly to the church.
