



# Learn ~ Aprender

#### **Deacon Jose Moronta**

### The first initiative of evangelization was like a sales campaign

Today's gospel tells us about Jesus sending 84 of his disciples for a missionary journey.

«...the Lord appointed seventy-two others whom he sent ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit...»

(The seventy-two "others" is a number in addition to the Twelve. That's why I said 84)

Before they depart, their teacher and leader gives them a "motivational speech" and some instructions. It's like we were listening to a sales manager preparing his staff as they get ready to set out on a new sales campaign. Jesus' disciples will go out to execute a sales job. They will be selling the Good News. His instructions are practical and specific, and might be applied to any other kind of endeavor:

- 1) Stay focused on the project at hand; allow no distractions.
- 2) Remember, you do not work alone; God is with you.
- 3) Pray and trust in God's help.
- 4) Stay alert at all times. Pay attention.
- 5) Value your product, because it is important.
- 6) Carefully discern when it is time to speak, time to be still.
- 7) If people are closed to you, you are wasting your time; move on.
- 8) Even then, leave a seed behind to take root and bear fruit later.
- 9) Remember, Christ will do the follow-up work; you prepare the way.
- 10) Pray for more workers; that's an essential part of the plan.

As any other good sales manager would do, Jesus also provides His workers with some information about the competition. There will be "snakes and scorpions," he warns them, using imaginative language to picture the obstacles they will have to overcome. Because He has prepared them so well, however, they have nothing to fear from any competitor. His sales crew is ready for the challenge. And it worked because upon their return they were excited and reported to Jesus,

«...The seventy-two returned rejoicing, and said, Lord, even the demons are subject to us because of your name...»

Even after being born two thousand years later, we're also members of Jesus' sales crew. We have been commissioned to sell the Good News to others... by word and example, by attitudes and behavior. When we come to Mass, when we read the Bible, when we meet with other Christians, we refresh our knowledge of the "product" we are called to sell. Let's be a champion team and beat the competition!

And have in mind that after doing the Lord's work we'll listen the same words he addressed to his apostles and disciples,

«Nevertheless, do not rejoice because the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice because your names are written in heaven...»

In observance of Independence Day, the Parish Office will be closed and Daily Mass will be celebrated at 8:30am and the Church will close for the rest of the day.

Make our vision clear and our will strong: that only in human solidarity will we find liberty, and justice only in the honor that belongs to every life on earth.


Turn our hearts toward the family of nations: to understand the ways of others, to offer friendship, and to find safety only in the common good of all. We ask this through Christ our Lord.



## St. Mark the Evangelist Church Soccer

A Catholic Youth Sports supported soccer program for boys and girls ages 5 – 17 and all athletic abilities is ready for a third (FALL 2022) season at St. Mark.

Season begins on August 27 with one practice (early evening) and one game (Saturday mornings) per week at St. Mark the Evangelist soccer fields as well as possibly a few other churches in the North Tampa area.

Program uses small sided games (4 to 5 players depending on age group).

Teams are projected include U(nder) 6 (born before 1/1/2016), U8 (1/1/2014), U10 (1/1/2012), U13 (1/1/2009) and U18 (1/1/2004) depending on registrations.

## **Tax Free Contribution Information**

If you are over 70 ½ and have an IRA or similar retirement account you may be required to take annual distributions prescribed by the IRS. These distributions are usually taxed at your ordinary income tax rate.

A new law was passed on 12/15/2015 which may allow you to contribute any part of your IRA including these required distributions to St. Mark TAX FREE!

Example: If you contribute \$5000 from your IRA to St. Mark and are in a 20% tax bracket, the church receives the \$5000 and you may save \$1000 in taxes.

A WIN-WIN for both the church and the parishioner!

If your tax advisor agrees and you want to contribute from your 2021/2022 required annual distributions or even from your current IRA,

instruct your IRA custodian to make the check out to: St. Mark the Evangelist Catholic Church.

They can either send it to you or directly to the church.

This is a great way to fulfill your pledge and/or contribute your annual offering in a lump sum.
