

## **Learn** ~ **Aprender Deacon Jose Moronta**

## Prophet Malachi warns unfaithful priests and Jesus condemns religious leaders who show off.

The first reading is taken from the Book of Malachi, which gets its name not from the author, who is unknown, but from the opening words of the book "An oracle. The word of the Lord to Israel through Malachi." Malachi is a Hebrew word meaning "my messenger." We know nothing of the author's life, but from his small book we learn something of the kind of person he was. Despite his attacks on priests, he was favorable to the Levitical priesthood, and he insisted on the people's obligation to contribute to the expenses of the Temple and the support of the personnel. In our reading today we hear God's messenger addressing the priests who have defiled God's altar by offering blind, diseased, and crippled animals instead of the unblemished as required. He also blames the lay people who brought them in the first place.

«...O priests, this commandment is for you: If you do not listen, and if you do not lay it to heart, to give glory to my name, says the Lord of hosts, I will send a curse upon you and of your blessing I will make a curse...» «...But you have turned aside from the way, and have caused many to falter by your instruction; You have made void the covenant of Levi, says the Lord of hosts...»

The priestly blessing brings a covenant curse because they have not obeyed the covenant.

In recent weeks we have been listening to a series of discussions or pronouncements by Jesus against the Pharisees who were hypocrites (which were not all) and the scribes, who were dedicated to the interpretation of the Holy Scriptures, but whose lives were not It reflected that proximity to the source of Divine Revelation which is the Word of God.

Last Sunday, in the Gospel Jesus was questioned by the chief priests, elders, and the scribes. This Sunday, Jesus addresses the crowds about their conduct.

#### «...All their works are performed to be seen. They widen their phylacteries...»

Phylacteries are small boxes containing parchment on which are written texts of Exodus, and Deuteronomy. These were fastened to the left wrist, and to the forehead in such a way that they hung in front of the eyes. Jesus says that they make them more noticeable, to impress regular people.

## «...They love places of honor at banquets, seats of honor in synagogues, greetings in marketplaces, and the salutation 'Rabbi.'...»

Jesus Christ is not questioning the authority of the religious leaders. Jesus does not reject the teachings of the scribes, but rather their way of behaving. Their message is not bad, but the example they set is. Jesus criticizes the incoherence, the divorce between faith and life, while he complains about how they take advantage of his religious position to satisfy their personal vanity.

## «... do and observe all things whatsoever they tell you, but do not follow their example. For they preach but they do not practice...»

Toward the end of today's gospel Jesus pronounces a controversial statement,

#### «... The greatest among you must be your servant...»

This text reinforces the teaching of humility. From the context it is clear that the prohibition is not the use of the title, but it is of not using the title if it is not earned and displayed in the actions of the bearer. Humility and service to God is what is important.

As a good teacher, Jesus does not stop at criticism. He says that for those who have some responsibility amid a community, it is better not to pursue power, or seek to be important, or promote the cult of their personality, but must be a servant. The first places are not important, but the last, because Christianity proposes a deeply egalitarian community, because all share God as Father and Christ as Master and Lord.

## St. Mark the Evangelist Catholic Church Soccer

A Catholic Youth Sports League soccer program for boys and girls ages 6 – 18 and all athletic abilities is ready for a sixth (Winter 2024) season at St. Mark.



## **Tax Free Contribution Information**

If you are over 73 and have an IRA or similar retirement account you may be required to take annual distributions prescribed by the IRS. These distributions are usually taxed at your ordinary income tax rate.

New laws have been passed which may allow you to contribute any part of your IRA including these required distributions to St. Mark TAX FREE!

Example: If you contribute \$5000 from your IRA to St. Mark and are in a 20% tax bracket, the church receives the \$5000 and you may save \$1000 in taxes.

A WIN-WIN for both the church and the parishioner!

If your tax advisor agrees and you want to contribute from your 2021/2023 required annual distributions or even from your current IRA,

instruct your IRA custodian to make the check out to: St. Mark the Evangelist Catholic Church.

They can either send it to you or directly to the church.
