


MOTHER'S DAY NOVENA



SON'S UP

When Mary Magdalene found the empty tomb, she did not hesitate to share that news with others. The Lord is not here. Where has he gone? And that haste translated to utter excitement, as it was an all-out race to the tomb to discover that indeed, he is not here! Has he risen?

It is Peter's initial witness of the empty tomb that gives him the power to proclaim confidently (in our first reading), "This man God raised on the third day and granted that he be visible, not to all the people, but to us, the witnesses chosen by God in advance." Peter's firsthand account of Christ's triumph over death should encourage us to proclaim the miracles we encounter in our own lives. When was the last time you ran to proclaim the Good News as Mary did, or spoke as confidently as St. peter that Jesus has risen?

"We are witnesses of all that he did." Maybe not in Jerusalem in the year AD 33, but indeed in our own lives. Today, be encouraged to share Christ's miraculous presence in your own life

Beyond just wrapping a corpse with burial linens, it was customary for the body to be anointed with oil and spices. It is for this reason that Mary Magdalene and the other women were headed to the tomb, as Jesus' burial was so quick because of the impending Sabbath, which had begun on Friday at sunset. It is when the Sabbath was over (ending Saturday at Sunset) that they were able to finish the burial process and anoint the Lord in the way he prophesied.

:ARRIBA EL HIJO!

Cuando María Magdalena encontró la tumba vacía, no dudó en compartir la noticia. El Señor no está. ¿Adónde se ha ido? Y esa prisa se tradujo en una emoción absoluta, pues corrió a toda velocidad hacia la tumba para descubrir que, efectivamente, ¡no estaba! ¿Ha resucitado?

Es el testimonio inicial de Pedro de la tumba vacía lo que le da la fuerza para proclamar con confianza (en nuestra primera lectura): «A este hombre Dios lo resucitó al tercer día y le concedió ser visible, no a todo el pueblo, sino a nosotros, los testigos escogidos por Dios de antemano». El relato directo de Pedro del triunfo de Cristo sobre la muerte debería animarnos a proclamar los milagros que encontramos en nuestras propias vidas. ¿Cuándo fue la última vez que corriste a proclamar la Buena Nueva como lo hizo María, o dijiste con la misma confianza que San Pedro que Jesús había resucitado?

«Somos testigos de todo lo que hizo». Quizás no en Jerusalén en el año 33 d. C., pero sí en nuestras propias vidas. Hoy, anímate a compartir la presencia milagrosa de Cristo en tu vida.

Más allá de simplemente envolver un cadáver con lienzos, era costumbre ungir el cuerpo con aceite y especias. Por esta razón, María Magdalena y las otras mujeres se dirigían al sepulcro, ya que el entierro de Jesús fue tan rápido debido a la inminencia del Sabbath, que había comenzado el viernes al atardecer. Fue al terminar el Sabbath (que terminaba el sábado al atardecer) que pudieron terminar el entierro y ungir al Señor como él profetizó.

PRAYER FOR THE WEEK

Thank you, most merciful Lord, for the incredible gift of your Resurrection. May I have the eyes to see your glory in the midst of suffering – the Resurrection in the midst of the Cross. This week, may I understand this mystery a little more and love you more deeply. Amen.
