The Food Pantry will be OPEN again on Wednesday, April 30th from 4pm until we run out of supplies.



PROVE IT

What kind of faith did people have to bring their sick close to Peter, just so that his shadow would fall on them? Certainly, they knew that healing had nothing to do with Peter, but everything to do with Christ—all of those nameless Christians trusted that Jesus was still working miracles.

And then there was St. Thomas. Poor Thomas. He ran out for groceries, and Jesus stopped by while he was gone. Upon St. Thomas's return, it may have seemed as if the rest of the group was playing a big prank on him. Jesus raised from the dead? Yeah, right. We would doubt too. Even in his doubt, Jesus still comes through for St. Tomas. This cannon be understated: Our doubts don't limit God. He can still surprise us and show up when we least expect him.

The Church recognizes this Sunday as Divine Mercy Sunday, and the readings call us to have great faith in Christ, especially in the mercy of Christ. Sometimes his mercy can be the most difficult thing to have faith in. Does Jesus still show me mercy even when I sin? When I doubt? When I am sick and broken in sin? The readings today proves us with the answer—an emphatic yes—and challenge us to elevate our faith even when we cannot see.

Not only is St. John's vision in Revelation set on "the Lord's day" (Sunday), but both Resurrection appearances to the apostles occur on the first day of the week, which is also Sunday. These mystical and physical interactions with God on Sunday are not coincidental; they are providential.

COMPRUÉBALO

¿Qué clase de fe tenían las personas para acercar a sus enfermos a Pedro, solo para que su sombra los cubriera? Ciertamente, sabían que la curación no tenía nada que ver con Pedro, sino con Cristo; todos esos cristianos anónimos confiaban en que Jesús seguía obrando milagros.

Y luego estaba Santo Tomás. Pobre Tomás. Salió corriendo a comprar comida, y Jesús pasó por allí mientras no estaba. Al regresar Santo Tomás, pudo parecer como si el resto del grupo le estuviera gastando una broma pesada. ¿Jesús resucitó? Sí, claro. Nosotros también dudaríamos. Incluso en su duda, Jesús sigue ayudando a Santo Tomás. Esta frase debe ser sutil: nuestras dudas no limitan a Dios. Él todavía puede sorprendernos y aparecer cuando menos lo esperamos.

La Iglesia reconoce este domingo como el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, y las lecturas nos llaman a tener una gran fe en Cristo, especialmente en su misericordia. A veces, su misericordia puede ser lo más difícil en lo que creer. ¿Me muestra Jesús misericordia incluso cuando peco? ¿Cuando dudo? ¿Cuando estoy enfermo y destrozado por el pecado? Las lecturas de hoy nos dan la respuesta —un sí rotundo— y nos desafían a elevar nuestra fe incluso cuando no podemos ver.

La visión de San Juan en el Apocalipsis no solo se sitúa en el "día del Señor" (domingo), sino que ambas apariciones de la Resurrección a los apóstoles ocurren el primer día de la semana, que también es domingo. Estas interacciones místicas y físicas con Dios el domingo no son casuales; son providenciales.

PRAYER FOR THE WEEK

Lord, your mercy is an ocean, and my sin is a very small drop in that ocean. May I never forget how generous you are. Open my heart to understanding your mercy better and recognizing where my own doubt closes me off to your love. Today, I pray more fervently for faith. Amen.

CHALLENGE OF THE WEEK

A beautiful practice at Mass, after the consecration when the priest elevates the Eucharist, is to pray in the silence of your heart, "My Lord and My God." We may not see Christ in the Eucharist as vividly as St. Thomas saw him after the Resurrection, but our faith does tell us that he is fully present within the Eucharist. This practice will help us to increase our faith in

Christ's Eucharistic presence and to receive blessings as Christ proclaimed, "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." So, this week during Mass, pray the following prayer after the consecration silently: "My Lord and my God, I believe; please help my unbelief! Amen."
