



ALL FOR ONE

Pride divides. Peace unifies. Pride is rooted in our human hearts. Peace is given by Christ.

The first reading from the book of Acts provides a great example of struggles the early Church faced (and that our Church faces still today) when prideful people took matters of teaching and authority into their own hands. They spread misinformation and actually prevented some people from following Christ. Not only did this false teaching divide people within the Church, but it also kept some people out of it. Pride can be destructive in ways we don't realize.

In the gospel, Jesus gives the disciples a command to keep God's word. When the disciples follow this command, good fruit is born and, over time, unity grows and peace is ushered in. The same is true today. When we love Christ and follow his commands, we experience both interior peace and peace in our community. Note that in the gospel Jesus doesn't say, "if you love me, modify my commands as you see fit," or, "If you love me, preach in your own name." if we love Christ, there is no room for pride. If we wan to serve Christ and others, pride will only divide. We know that we are living in the Holy Spirit and really proclaiming Christ when we bring people together in God's name rather than arguing and creating division.

TODOS PARA UNO

El orgullo divide. La paz unifica. El orgullo está arraigado en nuestros corazones. La paz la da Cristo.

La primera lectura del libro de los Hechos ofrece un gran ejemplo de las dificultades que enfrentó la Iglesia primitiva (y que nuestra Iglesia aún enfrenta hoy) cuando personas orgullosas tomaron la enseñanza y la autoridad en sus manos. Difundieron desinformación e incluso impidieron que algunas personas siguieran a Cristo. Esta falsa enseñanza no solo dividió a las personas dentro de la Iglesia, sino que también las mantuvo alejadas. El orgullo puede ser destructivo de maneras que no nos damos cuenta.

En el Evangelio, Jesús da a los discípulos el mandato de guardar la palabra de Dios. Cuando los discípulos siguen este mandato, nacen buenos frutos y, con el tiempo, crece la unidad y se instaura la paz. Lo mismo ocurre hoy. Cuando amamos a Cristo y seguimos sus mandatos, experimentamos paz interior y paz en nuestra comunidad. Cabe destacar que en el Evangelio Jesús **no dice**: "Si me aman, modifiquen mis mandatos como mejor les parezca", ni: "Si me aman, prediquen en su propio nombre". Ŝi amamos a Cristo, no hay lugar para el orgullo. Ŝi queremos servir a Cristo y a los demás, el orgullo solo nos dividirá. Sabemos que vivimos en el Espíritu Santo y proclamamos verdaderamente a Cristo cuando unimos a las personas en el nombre de Dios, en lugar de discutir y crear división.

PRAYER FOR THE WEEK

Lord, we need your peace. Amid the atrocities going on in our world, grant us peace. I know that they are out of my control, so I trust that your plans are greater than my own, that your hand is at work always. Help me to see your help in all things and seek your peace within my own heart and home. Holy Spirit, come today and dwell within my home. May my heart not be troubled or afraid. Amen.

CHALLENGE OF THE WEEK

Look up the Prayer of St. Francis online. This is the famous prayer for peace that begins, "Lord, make me an instrument of your peace." Pray it every day this week. And most importantly, pray it honestly and with conviction.
