


## MARK YOUR CALENDARS!!!



## **EN FUEGO**

Breath. Fire. Renewal. Gift. These words resonate off the pages of sacred scripture on Pentecost Sunday. In the gospel, the walls of a locked room cannot stop Jesus from breathing the Holy Spirit on the apostles. Jesus literally inspires them with the Holy Spirit. He breathes out, and they breathe in and receive. This reception is followed by Pentecost in the book of Acts. The Holy Spirit falls on the apostles as tongues of fire, and then they go and breathe that Spirit out through their words and actions. This is unprecedented! So much so that the people listening to the disciples think they are drunk.

We receive this same Holy Spirit through our baptism and confirmation, and we can call on him to inspire us. It is the Holy Spirit who gives us the power to proclaim Christ to others and, as St. Paul reminds the Corinthians, it is only through the Holy Spirit that we can call Jesus our Lord at all. Our faith is fully reliant on the Holy Spirit. Not only does the Spirit renew us as a breath of fresh air, but we can bring that Holy Spirit out to a world that desperately needs it – a world that is choking for lack of oxygen. Pentecost challenges us to be bold in that Spirit; the world cannot wait for us to act.

Though the exact location for Pentecost is not given, many scholars contend that it took place in the same upper room (also know as the cenacle) where the Last Supper was held seven weeks earlier. Many believe this home with the upper room to be owned by St. Mark's mother, as it served as sort of a home base for the apostles in Jerusalem (see Acts 12).

## EN FUEGO

Aliento. Fuego. Renovación. Don. Estas palabras resuenan en las páginas de las Sagradas Escrituras el Domingo de Pentecostés. En el Evangelio, las paredes de una habitación cerrada no pueden impedir que Jesús infunda el Espíritu Santo sobre los apóstoles. Jesús literalmente los inspira con el Espíritu Santo. Él exhala, y ellos inhalan y reciben. A esta recepción le sigue Pentecostés en el libro de los Hechos. El Espíritu Santo cae sobre los apóstoles como lenguas de fuego, y luego ellos van y exhalan ese Espíritu a través de sus palabras y acciones. ¡Esto es inaudito! Tanto es así que quienes escuchaban a los discípulos pensaron que estaban ebrios.

Recibimos este mismo Espíritu Santo a través de nuestro bautismo y confirmación, y podemos invocar su inspiración. Es el Espíritu Santo quien nos da el poder de proclamar a Cristo a los demás y, como San Pablo les recuerda a los corintios, solo a través del Espíritu Santo podemos llamar a Jesús nuestro Señor. Nuestra fe depende plenamente del Espíritu Santo. El Espíritu no solo nos renueva como un soplo de aire fresco, sino que también podemos llevar ese Espíritu Santo a un mundo que lo necesita desesperadamente, un mundo que se asfixia por la falta de oxígeno. Pentecostés nos reta a ser valientes en ese Espíritu; el mundo no puede esperar a que actuemos.

Aunque no se indica el lugar exacto de Pentecostés, muchos estudiosos sostienen que tuvo lugar en el mismo cenáculo donde se celebró la Última Cena siete semanas antes. Muchos creen que esta casa, con el cenáculo, era propiedad de la madre de San Marcos, ya que sirvió como una especie de base para los apóstoles en Jerusalén (véase Hechos 12).

## PRAYER FOR THE WEEK

Lord God, thank you for the gift of the Holy Spirit. Help me to grow in a greater understanding of how the Holy Spirit works in my life. May I open my eyes to see how he has already worked in my life and the areas that I need to change in order to invite him in more fully. Increase my understanding and trust so that the Holy Spirit can be my strength in times of need. Amen.

## CHALLENGE OF THE WEEK

Begin to actively seek a relationship with the Holy Spirit this week. He is not just an idea; he is the third person of the Trinity. Begin this week by praying St. Augustine's Prayer to the Holy Spirit every day, asking him to be more present within you:

Breathe in me, O Holy Spirit, that my thoughts may all be holy, Act in me, O Holy Spirit, that my work, too, may be holy. Draw my heart, O Holy Spirit, that I love what is holy. Strengthen me, O Holy Spirit, to defend all that is holy. Guard me, then, O Holy Spirit, that I always may be holy. Amen.
