In this Sunday's Gospel (Matthew 5:13-16), Jesus gives us two beautiful images. He calls us the salt of the earth and the light of the world.

Salt has value only when it keeps its taste. Light has meaning only when it shines. If salt loses its flavor, it becomes useless. If light is hidden, it helps no one. In the same way, we as Christians have an identity. Our life and identity are rooted in Jesus Christ. If we forget Him, we lose our purpose.

Jesus reminds us that our Christian life is based on one commandment: love. Without love, our faith becomes empty. We may do many things, but if there is no love, we are nothing. True Christian love is not easy. It is challenging. It calls us to forgive, to serve, and even to love our enemies.
