A Columbarium has niches that house urns containing cremated remains. The niches are inscribed with the person's name and dates of birth and death.

They are constructed to serve as a permanent resting place for your loved ones in a "churchyard" setting at Our Lady of the Lake Church. The price of a niche is \$2,500, which allows you to inter the cremains of two people.
