# WELCOME TO THE PARISH OF ST. JAMES THE APOSTLE AND OUR LADY OF THE LAKE/MT. CARMEL

Thank you for joining in our Eucharistic celebration. If you are a visitor, we welcome you and are glad that you are with us today. We hope that you will find nourishment for your faith and life here. If you have recently moved into our Parish, please come to the Parish Office at St. James to register and introduce yourself to the priests and staff.

The Fourth of July is that day that the Declaration of Independence was signed and Congress declared that the colonies were free from England. Actually, that declaration was voted on July 2nd, the revised edition of the Declaration was signed on the 4th. A common error accepted as fact by most people. Acceptance however does not guarantee fact, only truth guarantees fact.

With the recent ruling of the Supreme Court most people believe that the decision outlaws' abortion. Once again, a common error accepted as fact by many people. The Supreme Court decision only said that the "right" to abortion is not found in the Constitution, and it is not. That does not mean that abortion is outlawed by the nation as a whole but leaves that fact up to individual states to decide. However, most liberals, including members of the Congress and local/state governments are shouting that, that is what the decision does. Again, simply saying that loudly and often does not make it so.

The Congress is now holding hearings to determine if the former president is guilty of treason, inciting riot against the government or not. Those same people are inciting violence against the government, declaring that the Supreme Court is illegitimate and that we should, must, ignore their decisions. The protests all across our nation are causing unrest and call for violence against the very principals they claim they are defending. They call out for the people to defy whatever they see as wrong, as long as that vision is the same as their own and expand that condemnation to anything that they think will inhibit or limit their "rights".

Our nation chose as its national motto, "E Plurribus Unum", Out of Many One. I think that it may be time to change that motto to, Out of Many Even More. I do not understand how something can be one thing and its opposite at the same time. We call for healing among people all the while urging disunity. We have taken the idea that compromise means that you get your say and I get mine and then we do what I say. It is a time of confusion and violence seems to be the answer for any question that goes against my opinion. We will never have peace in our land until we heal ourselves, until we accept others as we would have them accept us. The Christian Creed to Love One another is the only answer to the discord we find ourselves in now.

Let us make our Prayer to St. Michael for our own nation, for the end of evil in our own lives and for peace, not only in Europe but in our own hearts and homes. Amen.
