WELCOME TO THE PARISH OF ST. JAMES THE APOSTLE AND OUR LADY OF THE LAKE/MT. CARMEL

Thank you for joining in our Eucharistic celebration. If you are a visitor, we welcome you and are glad that you are with us today. We hope that you will find nourishment for your faith and life here. If you have recently moved into our Parish, please come to the Parish Office at St. James to register and introduce yourself to the priests and staff.

Today, the **First Sunday of Advent**, the Church presents to us the prophecy, the vision of Isaiah. In the vision he sees the people of every nation joyfully making their way to the Jerusalem Temple, the Mountain of the Lord's house. Their goal is to learn the way of the Lord from the summit of the Mountain and to look for God's wisdom.

On that Mountain the Lord will teach them to promote peace instead of war. There will be no longer be a need for war. People will beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hook. Swords that once cut into human flesh will be refashioned into plowshares that cut into the ground for the planting of life-giving crops, and there will be great harvest of peace. Spears once raised to destroy life will be refashioned into pruning hook raised to trim trees so they yield good fruit to nourish life.

It is a wonderful vision, a vision of peaceable kingdom. It is not just a pleasant vision, but a call to action. Now is the time for action, for turning that dream, that vision into reality as Saint Paul tells us in the second reading today. He calls us to awake from sleep, to throw off the works of darkness, to put on the armor of light, to get moving, to get to work.

The world today is less safe. Poverty, suffering, war and destruction are daily struggles for millions of people. In his Encyclical Spe Salvi, Pope Benedict wrote: "We must do all we can to overcome suffering, but to banish it from the world is not in our power, only God is able to do this." The time is now. The Day of the Lord is now upon us. The transformation of the world has begun in Jesus Christ.

What are we to do to fulfill our part in the transformation of the whole world? There are so many things need to be done in the world today, to bring peace, freedom, security and prosperity to every single person. There are so many things need to be done in the work of transforming the world into the Kingdom of God. Don't expect to do great things, just do small acts of daily love. Every good thing we do, every act of kindness and love, every sacrifice of self for others, is always a small step in the work of transforming the world into the kingdom of God.

In this **Holy Season, the Season of Hope**, **of Action**, let us ask the Lord to bless us as we to work to fulfill our part in the work of transforming the world into the Kingdom of God.
