Monday, January 22nd is the 51st Anniversary of the Supreme Court decision Roe vs. Wade. On this anniversary all the Dioceses of the United States of America shall observe a day of prayer for full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.

Let us thank God for the gift of human life and pray for the end of abortion. Let us entrust all lives under the protection of Mary, Mother of the living:

Grant that all who believe in Your Son may proclaim the Gospel of Life with honesty and love to the people of our time. Obtain for them the grace to accept that Gospel as a gift ever new, the joy of celebrating it with gratitude throughout their lives and the courage to bear witness to it resolutely, in order to build, together with all people of good will, the civilization of truth and love, to the praise and glory of God, the Creator and lover of life."




