### **THE CONCLUSION OF THE CHRISTMAS SEASON**

The feast of the Baptism of the Lord on Monday brings the Christmas season to an end. To mark the day, here's a litany called "The Work of Christmas" composed by Howard Thurman, an African American theologian, educator, and civil rights leader.

*When the song of the angels is stilled,  
when the star in the sky is gone,  
when the kings and princes are home,  
when the shepherds are back with their flocks,  
the work of Christmas begins:  
to find the lost,  
to heal the broken,  
to feed the hungry,  
to release the prisoner,  
to rebuild the nations,  
to bring peace among the people,  
to make music in the heart.*

### **Ordinary Time after the Baptism of the Lord 2024**

Ordinary Time commences Tuesday, January 9th after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord through Shrove (Fat) Tuesday, February 13th. "Ordinary" does not mean "plain." The name comes from "ordinalis" meaning "showing order, denoting an order of succession." It is used in this sense to refer to the order of the counted weeks. That is to say, it is a season of counted weeks. This first segment of Ordinary Time focuses on the early life and childhood of Christ, and then on His public ministry. The liturgical color of Ordinary Time is green; however, as in all seasons, other appropriate colors are worn on particular feast days.

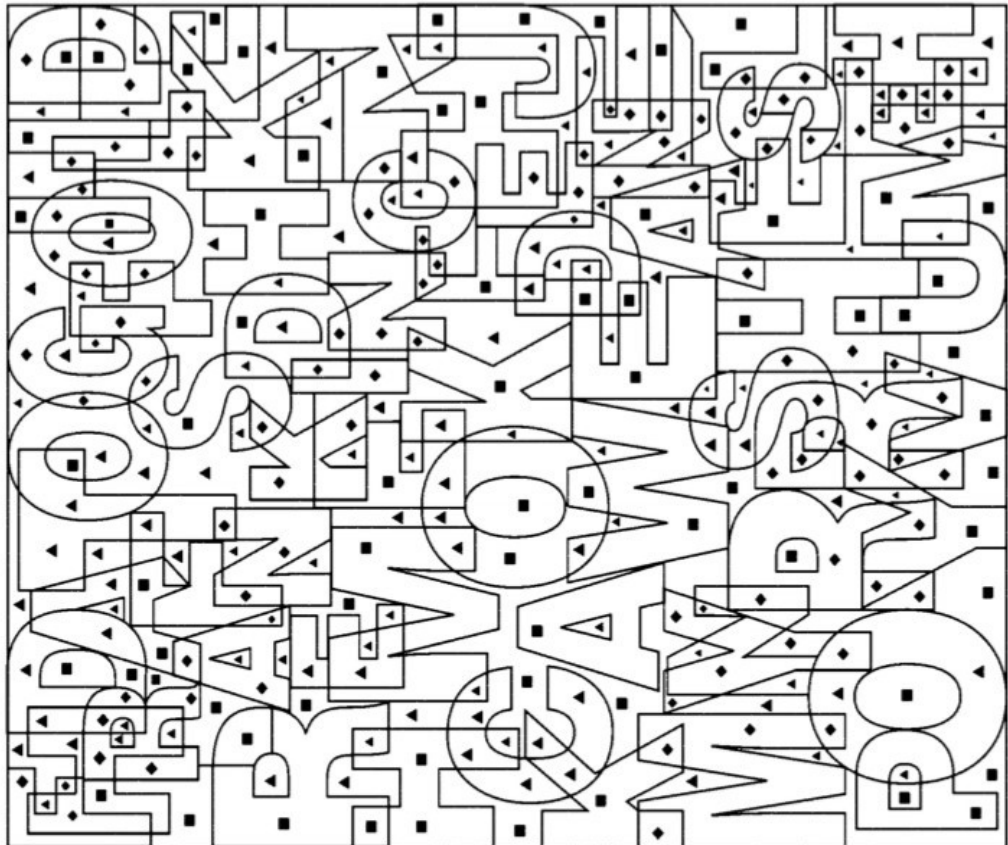

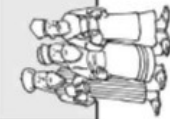

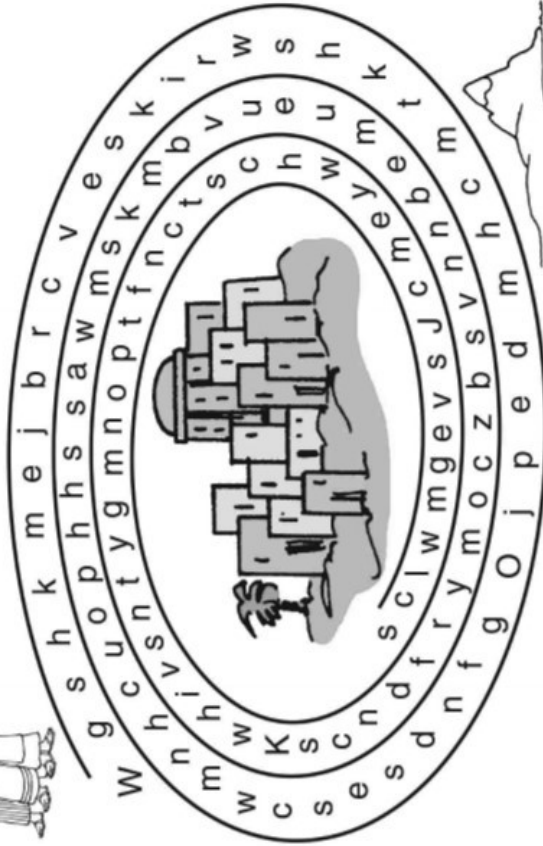
