EUCHARISTIC MINISTER, HOMEBOUND MINISTER AND LECTOR TRAINING

Shortly we will begin training sessions for Lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion at Mass and to the Homebound/Hospital/Nursing Homes Ministry.

What's expected? A candidate must be Catholic at least 14 years of age to become a Lector. 18 years of age to become a Eucharistic Minister, having received First Holy Communion and Confirmation. The candidate must be leading a life of faith in keeping with the function to be assumed, not bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared, be reverential, respectful of his/her faith, and of good moral character; and if married, be in a valid marriage according to the law of the Catholic Church.

Lectors should possess the necessary ability and talents to proclaim the Word of God in a clear, dignified, and effective manner.

Extraordinary Ministers who will bring Holy Communion to the sick should be able to minister to the sick in a compassionate, prayerful, and sensitive way. They should possess psychological maturity and the ability to keep confidence, not discussing indiscriminately the condition of patients or their homes.

HURRICANE RELIEF — We stand in solidarity with our suffering neighbors.

Cardinal Dolan has asked for prayers and support for our brothers and sisters in Florida and throughout the southeastern part of the United States.

As you have seen in the news, Hurricane Helene has created devastation in that part of our country. The rain and flooding have been unrelenting. Many have already died as some communities struggle to get basic supplies. It is the third deadliest storm of the 21st century, after Katria in 2005 and Maria in 2017.

As we often do in these situations, we instinctively want to be involved in the long-term recovery. The Cardinal knows the generosity of our people and their deep care for those in distress. Catholic Charities USA is the official domestic disaster relief agency of the Catholic Church in the United States.

We are taking up an emergency collection. Please drop an envelope in the collection or in the drop-box by the Parish Office. Write "Hurricane Relief" on the envelope. Checks may be made out to "St. James the Apostle Church." Write "Hurricane" in the memo line. We would be pleased to receive this by the end of October, if possible.

Given the urgency, the archdiocese will supplement what comes in so that those most in need can receive assistance quickly. The money will come from the archdiocese's charity emergency funds financed by a left-over balance from previous collections in parishes.

WHY CATHOLICS SHOULD

VOTE NO TO THE ERA

On November 5th, New Yorkers will vote on the "Equal Rights Amendment," or "Proposition One," a vaguely worded, unnecessary, and dangerous state constitutional amendment that would result in serious negative consequences by expanding "equal protection under the law" to include, among other things: age, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, and reproductive healthcare.

What would the ERA do?



1. Enshrine abortion up until birth in the New York State Constitution.

Abortion limitations to protect women and children would become impossible to pass. Conscience protections of health care professionals and individuals would also be threatened.



2. Allow children to make life-altering medical decisions without parental consent.

Children experiencing gender confusion would be able to seek gender reassignment therapies and surgeries without parental consent or knowledge.



3. Loosen age-appropriate restrictions.

Common sense age-restrictions on "sexual freedom" and the potential "right to die" would be endangered.
