Putnam Chorale's 2024 Winter Ensemble will perform "With Strings Attached" at St. James Church on Friday, December 13th at 7pm.


The Ensemble will present Vivaldi's Gloria, and Christmas Oratorio by Saint-Saens, under the direction of Jason C. Tramm


\$25.00 Adults, \$20 for Senior Citizens and Teens, Children under 12 are free.
