

### PASTOR'S ANNUAL REPORT

# September 2023 – August 2024 A TIME OF CHALLENGE, FAITH AND HOPE!

#### SUMMARY

- ➤ We are thankful to Father Kurpios for his years of generous and loving service to our parish and we congratulated him on is appointment as the new Pastor of St. John the Evangelist, Mahopac.
- ➤ With this change, the Polish Ministry has returned to Mahopac (weekly average of the 12:30pm Polish Mass until July 2024: 81 people, \$412) The Polish School continues to rent the lower level of Our Lady of the Lake / Mt. Carmel Church.
- We welcomed Fr. Robert Carolan as our new Parochial Vicar.
- Our wonderful St. James the Apostle School celebrated 70 years.
- ➤ Although in September 2023 the School was reorganized as part of the Catholic School Region of Northern Westchester/Dutchess, invoices for products and services prior to this point continued to be received until December 2023. The parish was responsible for those bills.
- > As previously reported, the revived Annual Parish Feast was quite successful.
- In September, we paid off the Religious Education Building Mortgage.
- ➤ The Finance Council approved the changing of the Gold Envelopes from Mortgage Payments to Parish Debt Relief (as of September 2024, the Parish Debt was: \$605,772.15).
- > Beginning September 2024, we are paying \$5,000 a month towards the parish debt.
- Overall, we are moving ahead with confidence; strong and healthy!

It seems that new initiatives and pastoral approaches have had a positive effect in building up parish ministries and stabilizing income. We owe a debt of gratitude to our lay leadership and countless volunteers. We also thank those who have maintained, and even increased, their weekly offertory. Especially noteworthy are those parishioners who signed up for *WeShare* electronic giving. Your continued generous stewardship has enabled us to keep up with day-day operations and programs.

Our Parish Trustees, Finance Council, and Pastoral Council are committed to providing responsible leadership as we move ahead. We thank our Parish Staff, Finance Council Chair, Joseph Groneman, CPA, and Parish Accountant, Eileen Podlovits, CPA, for their assistance in assembling this report.
