# WELCOME TO THE PARISH OF ST. JAMES THE APOSTLE AND OUR LADY OF THE LAKE/MT. CARMEL

Thank you for joining in our Eucharistic celebration. If you are a visitor, we welcome you and are glad that you are with us today. We hope that you will find nourishment for your faith and life here. If you have recently moved into our Parish, please come to the Parish Office at St. James to register and introduce yourself to the priests and staff.

### + LENT 2024 +

Lent is a holy season in our Church's year. It is holy because it calls us in a special way to holiness and encourages us to adopt holy habits of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. We should try to attend Mass as often as we can during Lent and pray the Rosary and make the Stations of the Cross. We should try to practice some form of self-denial or self-discipline during Lent – so that we might in some small way identify ourselves with Christ who was crucified for us. Also, we should try to make special sacrifices during Lent and practice acts of charity and almsgiving – and it is fortunate that the Cardinal's Stewardship Appeal continues throughout Lent so that we have a very practical opportunity to assist the Church's works of charity in New York.

During Lent the redder shade of purple is used if available, evoking the Blood of Jesus shed for us. The Pascal Candle (normally by the Baptismal Font) is put aside during Lent, brought out only for baptisms and funerals. Flowers are noticeably absent. Dried natural materials and bare and thorny branches remind us of passion themes. The penitential nature of Lent calls for specific seasonal music as well. Pain chant will be used at Mass.

#### **LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE**

During the season of Lent, the Church urges the faithful to reflect a spirit of penance in their daily lives through performing acts of fast and abstinence.

- +Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Thursday.
- +Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. This is a serious matter within Church law.
- +Fasting means only one full meal a day may be taken. Two smaller meals can be eaten to maintain physical strength but together they should not equal another full meal in quantity. Snacking between meals is not permitted. Catholics ages 18-59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are not specifically obliged to fast are encouraged to join in the discipline of fasting to the extent that they are able.
- +Abstinence forbids the eating of meat or poultry. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged to abstain on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent and continues to oblige throughout their lives. Those who are not specifically obliged to abstain from eating meat are urged to join in the discipline of abstaining to the extent that they are able.
- +Remember all Fridays of the year are designated as days of penance during which we are encouraged to practice self-denial out of gratitude for the suffering and death Jesus accepted for us.

### **Oppose Assisted Suicide**

The New York State Legislature has once again reintroduced the Medical Aid in Dying Act, bill number S2445 / A995. This bill will allow doctors to legally prescribe a lethal dose of pills at the request of a patient with a terminal illness or condition. The St. James Respect Life Group will have pre-written letters to our State Senator Peter Harckham for you to sign, asking him to desist from promoting this bill. Letters are available in the church lobbies. Our similar campaign a few years ago was very successful, and we ask for your support once again to keep this legislation from reaching the NYS Assembly and Senate floors for a vote.

The *Cursillos de Christiandad* is an international lay movement founded in 1944 in Spain by a group of laymen aimed at teaching men and women how to become more effective Christian leaders in parishes, work situations, and other environments. The weekend retreats help participants to form a closer relationship with Christ and a deeper experience of Christian community. It was officially recognized by Pope St. Paul VI, who designated the *Cursillos* as a renewal movement of the church.




