

# WELCOME TO THE PARISH OF ST. JAMES THE APOSTLE AND OUR LADY OF THE LAKE/MT. CARMEL

Thank you for joining in our Eucharistic celebration. If you are a visitor, we welcome you and are glad that you are with us today. We hope that you will find nourishment for your faith and life here. If you have recently moved into our Parish, please come to the Parish Office at St. James to register and introduce yourself to the priests and staff.

#### **Mother's Day Mass Remembrance**

As a spiritual gift, have your dear mother remembered at the Altar of Sacrifice during our Mother's Day Masses. Extra Mother's Day intention envelopes will be available at the doors of the churches. Feel free to use both sides of the envelope to record the names of (living and deceased) mothers, grandmothers, godmothers and other motherly women in your life and the life of your family.

You may place it in the collection or drop it off at the Parish Office. All Mother's Day Masses, will be offered for these special intentions, with the exception of the 12:30pm Mass at OLL, which is offered for all the people of the parish The envelopes will then be placed near the Tabernacle for the Month of May.

#### ATTENDING MASS WITH SMALL CHILDREN

You are most welcome to come with all the kids to the 10:00am Family Mass, a child-friendly liturgy where the movement and noise of little ones in the church is most welcome.

During other Masses at St. James, you are encouraged to use the main lobby and the hall by the bathrooms to sit with noisy young children. Chairs are provided. This keeps the noise to a minimum in the church itself and provides spaces during Mass for the gradual socialization of our little ones into the practice of Sunday worship. We encourage those with little ones to bring them to church and to use these options.

#### **SOUND SYSTEM UPGRADES**

Thanks to a recent donation from the Knights of Columbus and two generous parishioners, we were able to do some work on our sound system in St. James Church. Burnt-out amplifiers were replaced and wireless mics were upgraded. The speakers in the main lobby and in the hall by the bathrooms were repaired. Also the system at Our Lady of the Lake received some needed adjustments. Thank you donors for your support!

#### ST. JAMES PARKING LOT

Please note that we have put back the speed bumps in our parking lot due to an increasing number of cars that have been speeding through it, endangering us all, especially seniors and children. We ask all visitors to "slow down" and to observe all directional signs.

#### **ENCOUNTERS WITH THE RISEN CHRIST**

Just before the Solemnity of the Ascension, we mark and celebrate the appearances or encounters the apostles and first disciples had of the risen Christ before He ascended into heaven. On **May 7**<sup>th</sup> at 7pm in St. James the Apostle, we will mark by word and song the 7 traditional encounters remembered in the Byzantine liturgy. Take a look at the icons hanging on the wall outside the Parish Office.

#### **EASTER DUTY**

Due of the central importance of Easter to the Christian faith, the Catholic Church requires that all Catholics who have made their First Communion receive the Holy Eucharist sometime during the Easter season, which lasts through Pentecost Sunday, 50 days after Easter (Church Law extends the time when this duty may be fulfilled until Trinity Sunday, an extra two weeks!). They should also take part in the Sacrament of Penance before receiving this Easter Communion. This reception of the Eucharist is a visible sign of our faith and our participation in the Kingdom of God. Of course, we should receive Communion as frequently as possible (as long as we are in the state of grace); this "Easter Duty" is simply the minimum requirement set by the Church.

#### **ALPHA Marriage Course**

The **Office of Family Life** invites all married couples in the Archdiocese of New York to take part in the ALPHA Marriage Course! This series of 7 video sessions is designed to promote open, honest, and productive conversation between spouses on the topics of connection, communication, conflict, forgiveness, family, sex, and acts of love. There is no discussion or sharing with the larger group, so you can use this time to get to know and grow with your spouse without fear of judgment or lack of privacy!

The Course is by Zoom every Thursday from May 16 to June 27, from 7:00 PM to approximately 9:00 PM.




"The Tenderness of God's Whisper" is the theme for our Women's Tea and Retreat



The Retreat Center is located in Sag Harbor, in Suffolk County NY.






