Thank you for joining in our Eucharistic celebration. If you are a visitor, we welcome you and are glad that you are with us today. We hope that you will find nourishment for your faith and life here. If you have recently moved into our Parish, please come to the Parish Office at St. James to register and introduce yourself to the priests and staff.

The Kingdom Of God

In the Gospel today Jesus uses the parables of the seeds to reveal to us the mystery of the Kingdom of God. The mustard seed is a very tiny seed, but when it grows up, it becomes a mustard shrub, around seven feet tall. Through the parable of the tiny seed Jesus tells us that the Kingdom of God is a reality that is manifested in the ordinary, unattractive things of everyday life, and in our own lives.

When Jesus began his public ministry he walked along the roads of the towns and villages of Israel, wearing simple clothes, simple sandals, or even bare foot, meeting ordinary people, proclaiming the presence of the Kingdom of God, calling people to repent, healing the sick, feeding the hungry, choosing a small group of Twelve, a group of 72. That was the way he sowed the seed of his kingdom here on earth.

Many people thought that the Kingdom of God could be found in the great, the grand, and the glorious, far greater than any Kingdom here on earth. For many others it is to be found only with the heavenly Hosts, with Cherubim and Seraphim. No, it is to be found in the ordinary, like the little seed sown in the field. That is why Jesus used such humble image so that we may come to know, to experience in our own life, in our daily working and living the reality, the presence of his Kingdom among us, so that we may begin to enter, to become citizens of his Kingdom even when we are still here on the earth.

The Kingdom of God continues to be manifested in the ordinary things of everyday life; and it is to be present in the ordinary people like us, in married couples, in the workers in the public office or in the factories, in the regular soldiers who fight for our freedom.

The seed of his Kingdom, the seed of faith, the seed of salvation have been sown in our lives beginning at our baptism; and then everyday, as we pray, as we receive the sacraments we allow the seed to grow. It is not we who make the seed grow but God himself.

Lord Jesus, we are just like a tiny seed in your hands. Sow us into the field of our family, of our world, and make it grow and bear fruit: the fruit for your glory, the fruit for our salvation.

These are a few of the words that former participants in the OCIA and OCIT (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults/Teens) process have used to describe the life changing spiritual gifts they have received as a result. The Catholic faith is an encounter and relationship with God who created us to know, love, and serve Him, starting now in this life and eternally. It is God, and God alone, who gives us these spiritual gifts, and much more.

God has provided a means to draw us close to Him. We call it the Church. He equipped it with extraordinary, supernatural treasures which we call the sacraments (baptism, Eucharist, confirmation, penance, anointing of the sick, matrimony, and holy orders). He puts into our hearts the desire to seek him and know him.

Last April, seven adults chose to enter the OCIA process of education and formation in the Catholic faith and entered fully into the life of the Church receiving the sacraments of initiation. (baptism, Eucharist, confirmation) Seven more adults, and seven teens, already baptized but never fully initiated, also made the journey to full communion with the Lord in His Church.

If you are on the outside looking in and are curious, or want to join the Church but are already baptized in another Christian Church, or have the desire to complete the sacraments of Initiation (Eucharist, confirmation) and become a full member of God's Church, the OCIA and OCIT is for you.

Cardinal Dolan has assigned Father Robert Carolan to St. James the Apostle / Our Lady of the Lake / Mt. Carmel Parish as our new Parochial Vicar. Father Carolan, 40, was born in Ridgewood, N.J. and raised in Yorktown Heights, Westchester County, N.Y. He attended St. Elizabeth Ann Seton School and Yorktown High School. He earned a bachelor's degree in applied sociology from East Carolina University in North Carolina and a master's in physical education in sports pedagogy from Manhattanville College in Purchase. After teaching in Catholic schools for a few years, he entered St. Joseph's Seminary where he earned a bachelor's degree in sacred theology, a master's of divinity, and a master's in dogmatic theology. As a seminarian, he served at St. Therese's Parish on Staten Island, Saint Mary - St. Joseph - Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Parish in Poughkeepsie, and at St. Christopher's Inn at Graymoor in Garrison. His Deacon preaching assignment was at St. Theresa's Parish in Pelham Bay, the Bronx. Ordained a priest by Cardinal Dolan on May 29, 2021, he was assigned as a Parochial Vicar at Annunciation - Our Lady of Fatima in Westchester County. He will join us in July.


