These are a few of the words that former participants in the OCIA and OCIT (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults/Teens) process have used to describe the life changing spiritual gifts they have received as a result. The Catholic faith is an encounter and relationship with God who created us to know, love, and serve Him, starting now in this life and eternally. It is God, and God alone, who gives us these spiritual gifts, and much more.

God has provided a means to draw us close to Him. We call it the Church. He equipped it with extraordinary, supernatural treasures which we call the sacraments (baptism, Eucharist, confirmation, penance, anointing of the sick, matrimony, and holy orders). He puts into our hearts the desire to seek him and know him.

Last April, seven adults chose to enter the OCIA process of education and formation in the Catholic faith and entered fully into the life of the Church receiving the sacraments of initiation, Eucharist and confirmation. Seven teens, already baptized but never fully initiated, also made the journey to full communion with the Lord in His Church.






