# WELCOME TO THE PARISH OF ST. JAMES THE APOSTLE AND OUR LADY OF THE LAKE/MT. CARMEL

Thank you for joining in our Eucharistic celebration. If you are a visitor, we welcome you and are glad that you are with us today. We hope that you will find nourishment for your faith and life here. If you have recently moved into our Parish, please come to the Parish Office at St. James to register and introduce yourself to the priests and staff.

#### **Pentecost**

"Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." (John 20:21)



In the Gospel today, as Jesus appeared to his disciples twice, he said to them, "Peace be with you." The world is crying out for peace. Let us look at the world today: war and violence, shooting at schools, at shopping malls, on the streets. And let us look at our own lives, among members of our family, relatives, friends and neighbors, we often have to face some kind of little conflict, little confrontation, little war, and some of them last for years.

The peace that Jesus desires to give is more than an absence of war, of conflict, of violence, but a reconciliation between peoples and nations, and especially reconciliation between God and men. That is why after wishing them peace Jesus gives his disciples authority to forgive sins, reconciling men to God, and one to another. "Receive the Holy Spirit, whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained."

We often pray or sing the Prayer of Saint Francis. That prayer reminds us to put what we pray into actions, asking the Lord to help us to be channel, to be instrument of his peace:

Where there is hatred, we are called to sow love.

Where there is injury, pardon.

Where there is doubt, faith.

Where there is despair, hope.

Where there is darkness, light.

Where there is sadness, joy.

Saint Francis, pray for us. Help us to live as you lived, and to love as you loved. Love is the way to peace. Today as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Pentecost let us pray: Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Amen.

### 10 THINGS EVERY CATHOLIC SHOULD KNOW ABOUT PENTECOST

- 1. Pentecost Sunday marks the day when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles.
- 2. Pentecost Sunday occurs 50 days after Easter.
- 3. The Bible records the Pentecost in Acts 2:1-13.
- 4. Pentecost comes 10 days after the Ascension of Jesus Christ.
- 5. Pentecost is also known as "the birthday of the Church".
- 6. Pentecost fulfills Jesus' promise to send the "Counselor" and "Spirit of Truth" in John 16-5-15.
- 7. Pentecost launches the large-scale spreading of the Gospel after Jesus' ascension. Acts 2:41 records that after Peter spoke to the crowd after receiving the Holy Spirit, some 3,000 people were baptized.
- 8. The Pentecostal movement derives its name from the New Testament event in Acts 2.
- 9. Jews also celebrate Pentecost, but not for the same reason as Christians. The celebration by Jews of Pentecost is to observe God giving the Ten Commandments on Mount Sinai 50 days after the Exodus. The Pentecost in Jewish tradition takes place 50 days after Passover.
- 10. In Western Churches, Pentecost is usually represented with the color red, which symbolizes the fire of the Holy Spirit.

#### Last Mortgage Payment Made...

In 1995, the parish built the Religious Education Center (with Doherty Hall) to serve the growing needs of our parish. The building was financed by parishioner project contributions and a \$600,000 mortgage (30 years) from PCSB bank. Through your faithful use of the *Gold Envelope*, the last bank mortgage payment was just made. We thank all those who contributed weekly/monthly in the *Gold Envelope* to accomplish this.

#### Pay Off Our Debt...

As reported in the Parish August 31, 2023 Annual Report, during the period 2002 to 2023 the Archdiocese, on behalf of our parish, has paid our bills for pensions, medical benefits, and insurance as an "interest free" loan. Our debt to the Archdiocese as of March 2024 is \$2,051,279 (\$1,421,344 for the school, \$629,935 for the parish). The current fiscal year 2024 Archdiocese bills and all other bills are being paid by the weekly collections. In order to pay down this significant debt, we ask you to continue to use the monthly gold envelope, now to be labeled *Debt Reduction*.




