STAINED GLASS

Have you ever noticed driving by St. James Church on Rt. 52, that from the outside, there is no light in the stained-glass windows, no discernable form, or figures, or meaning? They are always just dark. It is only when you come inside the church, in the light of day, that the incredible beauty, message, and vibrancy of the colors come fully alive.

The five scenes from the Gospels take on form, shape, meaning...but only from the inside. It is the same with Catholics who never received adequate formation in the faith leading to the sacrament of confirmation, or those who aren't even Catholic, but wonder about the seemingly obscure and mysterious teachings of the Catholic faith and what's on the "other side" of those dark, mysterious windows.

Don't remain "outside", or only partly inside, and miss seeing the awesome beauty and truth of the faith. Come into the fullness of the light of the Catholic Faith.


